- 3 Call for appearances.
- 4 MR. HERRMANN: Mr. Examiner, Keith Herrmann
- 5 representing the Oil Conservation Division Compliance
- 6 and Enforcement Bureau.
- 7 EXAMINER JONES: Any other appearances?
- 8 MR. HERRMANN: Since there are no other
- 9 appearances, we will be submitting this case via
- 10 affidavit as well. And for the record, this is the
- 11 application -- this is Case Number 20144, application of
- 12 the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division Compliance and
- 13 Enforcement Bureau for a compliance order against
- 14 Quality Transport, Incorporated, for wells operated in
- 15 Eddy County, New Mexico.
- 16 Mr. Examiner, we have Daniel Sanchez
- 17 present, but in the interest of time, we will again be
- 18 submitting his testimony via affidavit, which is
- 19 contained in Exhibit 4. And just to summarize:
- 20 Exhibit 1 is an OCD record of the inactive
- 21 well list showing that this well has not produced -- or
- 22 had reported production since November of 2008.
- It has a single-well bond of \$17,026, and
- 24 that is identified in Exhibit 2, which is a printout of
- 25 the inactive well additional financial assurance report,

- 1 a record regularly kept by the Division.
- 2 Exhibit 3 is a notice of violation that was
- 3 sent by the Division prior to -- or at least 60 days
- 4 prior to the commencement of this proceeding, as
- 5 required by 19.15.5.9 NMAC.
- 6 Exhibit 4, as I previously stated, is an
- 7 affidavit of Daniel Sanchez going into greater detail of
- 8 what I am summarizing right now.
- 9 And Exhibit 5 is an Affidavit of Service
- 10 showing that we have served above and beyond what's
- 11 required by the Division to all the addresses we have on
- 12 file with the Division for Quality Transport and those
- 13 identified on the New Mexico Secretary of State Web
- 14 site, and we have sent notice directly to First American
- 15 Bank in Artesia. That is the holder of their financial
- 16 assurance.
- 17 At this time I'd move to admit Exhibits 1
- 18 through 5.
- 19 EXAMINER JONES: Exhibits 1 through 5 are
- 20 admitted.
- 21 (NMOCD Compliance and Enforcement Bureau
- 22 Exhibit Numbers 1 through 5 are offered and
- 23 admitted into evidence.)
- 24 MR. HERRMANN: And I would request that the
- 25 Division issue an order requiring this subject well, the

- 1 Helena 25 Fee Com #1, to be plugged and abandoned within
- 2 45 days, and should the operator fail to comply with
- 3 this order, that the Division be authorized to plug and
- 4 abandon this well and recoup its expenses from the
- 5 operator's financial assurance.
- 6 EXAMINER JONES: To summarize, all three of
- 7 these cases were one well plugging cases? No bonding
- 8 issues?
- 9 MR. HERRMANN: Just that they do have bonds
- 10 and we have notified the surety as required. Should the
- operator not comply with the order, we intend to call
- 12 that bond.
- 13 EXAMINER JONES: Okay. Thank you very
- 14 much.
- Thank you, both.
