HERRMANN: Yes. 5 EXAMINER JONES: Call Case 20199, application of New Mexico Oil Conversation Division 6 7 Compliance and Enforcement Bureau. 8 Call for appearances. MR. HERRMANN: Mr. Examiner, Keith Herrmann 9 representing the Oil Conservation Division Compliance 10 11 and Enforcement Bureau. 12 EXAMINER JONES: Any other appearances in 13 this case? 14 Please proceed. MR. HERRMANN: Mr. Examiner, since there 15 are no other appearances in this case, I'll just read 16 for the record that this is the application of the 17 18 New Mexico Oil Conservation Division Compliance and 19 Enforcement Bureau for a compliance order against S & D 20 Partnership for wells operated in Lea County, New Mexico. 21 22 We have prepared five exhibits that we will submit for the record, including an affidavit for 23 24 testimony for Mr. Daniel Sanchez. Sorry. I'm short on 25 exhibits.

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Page 4 In summary, this is a plugging case. 1 We are requesting the Division to issue a plugging order 2 for the Drinkard Homestead #1 well. It last produced in 3 September 2014 according to the Division records, and 4 that's contained in Exhibit 1. 5 It has -- let's see. It has two bonds on 6 7 the -- there are two wet bonds on this well, one blanket 8 bond for \$50,000 and another single-well bond for 9 \$12,817, that in the event the Division has to plug and abandon the well, we would ask, in an order, that we be 10 11 authorized to recoup our plugging expenses. Exhibit 3 is a letter violation that was 12 sent to the operator at least 60 days prior to the 13 commencement of this proceeding. 14 Exhibit 4 is the affidavit of Daniel 15 16 Sanchez that's notarized stating the facts I just briefly summarized. 17 18 And Exhibit 5 is an exhibit prepared 2 by 19 myself, an Affidavit of Service, showing that we have 20 notified both banks holding the financial assurance and the operator to all the addresses that we have on file 21 with the OCD. 22 23 If there are no further questions, I request that this case be taken under advisement. 24 25 The James Pope Stone EXAMINER JONES:

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Page 5 National Bank I think has been changed to a community 1 bank, but I'm not sure about that. That was my hometown 2 3 bank, so I pay attention to those kind of things. MR. HERRMANN: Well, we sent notice 4 5 directly to them because I believe it's a cash bond that б they have there, and we also notified the Hartford 7 Accident & Indemnity Corporation via the New Mexico 8 Superintendent of Insurance. 9 EXAMINER JONES: Okay. This is just a one well plugging case? There is no bonding issues here? 10 11 MR. HERRMANN: No. They are adequately 12 bonded. And if they -- we're requesting that the 13 Division issue an order ordering the operator plug and abandon this well within 45 days, and if they don't, 14 that the Division be authorized to plug and abandon the 15 16 well in accordance with the Division-approved plugging program and that we recoup our expenses from the bonding 17 18 that the operator has on file with the OCD. 19 EXAMINER JONES: Okay. That sounds good. 20 MR. HERRMANN: I wold also move to admit 21 Exhibits 1 through 5. 22 Is that okay, Mr. Brooks? EXAMINER JONES: 23 EXAMINER BROOKS: Fine with me. 24 EXAMINER JONES: Exhibits 1 through 5 are 25 admitted.
