STATEMENT OF CASE

In Case No. 16282 Novo seeks an order (1) creating a non-standard 320.00 acre, more or less, spacing unit in the Culebra Bluff; Bone Spring, South Pool (15011) limited to all depths below 8,773 feet to the base of the Bone Spring formation, comprised of the S/2S/2 of Section 4 and S/2S/2 of Section 5, Township 23 South, Range 29 East, Eddy County, New Mexico; and (2) pooling all uncommitted mineral interests underlying this proposed spacing unit. NOVO proposes to dedicate the S/2S/2 of Section 4 and S/2S/2 of Section 5, Township 23 South, Range 29 East, Eddy County, New Mexico to the Rana Salada Fed Com 0504 134H well which will be drilled from a surface location in the SE/4SE/4 of Section 6, Township 23 South, Range 29 East (Unit P), to a first take-point location in the SW/4SW/4 of Section 5, Township 23 South, Range 29 East (Unit M), to a bottom hole location in the SE/4SE/4 of Section 4, Township 23 South, Range 29 East (Unit P).

In Case No. 16283 Novo seeks an order (1) creating a non-standard 320.00 acre, more or less, spacing unit in the Culebra Bluff; Bone Spring, South Pool (15011) limited to all depths below 8,773 feet to the base of the Bone Spring formation, comprised of the N/2S/2 of Section 4 and N/2S/2 of Section 5, Township 23 South, Range 29 East, Eddy County, New Mexico; and (2) pooling all uncommitted mineral interests underlying this proposed spacing unit. Novo proposes to dedicate the N/2S/2 of Section 4 and N/2S/2 of Section 5, Township 23 South, Range 29 East, Eddy County, New Mexico to the Rana Salada Fed Com 0504 133H well which will be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the NE/4SE/4 of Section 6, Township 23 South, Range 29 East (Unit I), to a first take-point location in the NW/4SW/4 of Section 5, Township 23 South, Range 29 East (Unit L), to a bottom hole location in the NE/4SE/4 of Section 4, Township 23 South, Range 29 East (Unit I).

Case Nos. 16282 and 16283 were initially heard by the Division on July 12, 2018 and the record supplemented on August 9, 2018. To address the existing depth severance within the Bone Spring Sand formation underlying a 40-acre tract within the proposed spacing units in both Case Nos. 16282 and 16283, these cases were amended and re-noticed to reflect the revised proposed spacing and proration units limited to all depths below 8,773 feet to the base of the Bone Spring formation. The completed intervals for the proposed wells will be orthodox.
