1 HEARING EXAMINER: Now we will continue on to

- 2 Case Number 16081. Mewbourne Oil Company to re-open Case
- 3 16081 for compulsory pooling, Eddy County.
- 4 MR. BRUCE: Jim Bruce of Santa Fe representing
- 5 the applicant, again, and I'm submitting this case by
- 6 affidavit.
- 7 MS. BROGGI: Julia Broggi with Holland & Hart on
- 8 behalf of DOGY, DOGA and DOGM, and we do not object.
- 9 MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, this case, 16081, is
- 10 again a re-opened case. It was previously pooled, and after
- 11 the last hearing it was determined there were some
- 12 additional interest owners who needed to be pooled, so we
- 13 are here today seeking to pool additional interest owners
- into the Rustler Breaks 26/23 1H Well and 2H Well.
- 15 They are horizontal wells in the Purple Sage
- 16 Wolfcamp Gas Pool, with the W/2 of 26 and SW/4 of 23, 24
- 17 South, 28 East dedicated to the well.
- 18 The affidavit contains the usual information.
- 19 There is no depth severance in the Wolfcamp Formation. They
- 20 have made a good-faith effort to locate these people and
- 21 negotiate, and they are requesting 8000 a month for a
- 22 drilling well and 800 a month for a producing well.
- 23 Attached to Exhibit 1 is an affidavit of Josh
- 24 Anderson, landman, C-102s. And if you go to Attachment B,
- 25 as in boy, you will see a list of interest owners, and you

1 will see that the four people are being -- the ones with

- 2 asterisks by their names, are being pooled, a total of about
- 3 5.5 percent.
- 4 These people -- well, they're seeking heirs or
- 5 devisees of two decedents, and Ruth Roberts, and Maddox
- 6 Energy. Maddox Energy is unlocatable. The decedents are
- 7 unreachable, but they have been negotiating with their
- 8 heirs. And the affidavit contains the proposal letters and
- 9 summary of contacts, along with the AFEs for the wells, and
- 10 they're both just under about \$9.5 million wells.
- 11 Exhibit 2 is my affidavit of notice. The only
- 12 green card we got back was from Ruth Roberts, and I never
- 13 got the other letters back, even though, if you look at the
- 14 summary of contacts, Mewbourne has been in touch with the
- 15 heirs of the decedents. And, as a result, we published
- 16 noticed as against all of the parties being pooled so
- 17 everybody received either actual or constructive notice.
- 18 And with that, I -- and we are not submitting a
- 19 geologic affidavit because that was previously submitted.
- 20 Geology was discussed in the original hearing, and that
- 21 hasn't changed, so if we can just incorporate that geologic
- 22 testimony in the record.
- 23 And I ask that Exhibits 1 through 3 be admitted
- 24 to the record and the case be taken under advisement.
- 25 HEARING EXAMINER: Exhibits 1 through 3 will be
