#### APPLICANT

Applicant seeks an order pooling all mineral interests in the Wolfcamp formation underlying a 320-acre horizontal spacing unit in the Wolfcamp formation comprised of the N/2S/2 of Section 23 and the N/2S/2 of Section 24, Township 20 South, Range 30 East, NMPM. The unit will be dedicated to the Red Hornet Fed. Com. Well No. 702H, a horizontal Wolfcamp well with a first take point in the NE/4SE/4 of Section 24 and a last take point in the NW/4SW/4 of Section 23. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the well and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the well, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well.
