APPLICANT'S STATEMENT OF CASE

In Case No. 20546, Matador Production Company seeks an order pooling all uncommitted interests in the Wolfcamp formation (Burton Flat East; Upper Wolfcamp (Pool Code 98315)) in a standard 160-acre, more or less, horizontal spacing unit comprised of the N/2 S/2 of Section 19, Township 20 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico. The

spacing unit will be dedicated to the proposed **Stebbins 19 Fed Com No. 203H Well**, which will be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the NE/4 SE/4 (Unit I) of Section 19 to a bottom-hole location in the NW/4 SW/4 (Unit L) of Section 19. The completed interval for these wells will remain within the standard offset required by the statewide rules set forth in 19.15.16.15 NMAC.

The completed interval for these wells will remain within the standard offset required by the statewide rules set forth in 19.15.16.15 NMAC.
