HARDY: Good morning. Dana Hardy, with 6 7 the Hinkle firm, on behalf of Mewbourne. 8 EXAMINER DAWSON: Any witnesses? 9 MS. HARDY: No. We're presenting the case by affidavit. 10 11 EXAMINER DAWSON: Okay. 12 MR. CARR: May it please the examiner, 13 William F. Carr for COG Operating. MR. BRUCE: Jim Bruce for ConocoPhillips. 14 15 EXAMINER DAWSON: Okay. When you're ready, 16 Ms. Hardy. 17 MS. HARDY: Thank you. 18 Mewbourne's application seeks the pooling 19 of all uncommitted interests in the Bone Spring 20 Formation and a standard 400-acre horizontal spacing unit comprised of the south half of the south half of 21 Section 3, the south half of the south half of Section 4 22 23 and the south half of the southeast quarter of Section 24 5, Township 20 South, Range 30 East in Eddy County. The 25 horizontal spacing unit will be dedicated to the Caballo

1 Loco 3/5 B2PO Fed Com #1H well.

Exhibit 1 is a self-affirmed statement of 2 the landman, Mitch Robb. The attachments to his 3 afterward include a Midland Map identifying the 4 5 horizontal spacing unit, a chart of tract ownership, 6 documents addressing Mr. Robb's well proposals, notice 7 of today's hearing and an AFE for the well. As Mr. Robb 8 notes in his affidavit, there are no depth severances in 9 the Bone Spring Formation. Mewbourne is requesting overhead and administrative rates of 8,000 a month and 10 11 800 a month, which are the same as the rates in Mewbourne's JOA for the well. And finally, Mewbourne is 12 requesting a 200 percent risk penalty. 13 14 Exhibit Number 2 is a self-affirmed statement of geologist Charles Crosby. Attached to 15 16 Mr. Crosby's affidavit are a structure map of the base of the Bone Spring Sand, a gross sand isopach map, a 17 18 west-to-east cross section, a table containing information from other wells drilled in the vicinity and 19 20 a survey calculation report for the proposed well. As stated in Mr. Crosby's affidavit, the 21 22 horizontal spacing unit is justified from a geologic standpoint. A west-to-east or east-to-west orientation 23 24 is preferred. There is no faulting or other geologic 25 impediments that might adversely affect the drilling of

Page 5 the proposed well, and each quarter section of the 1 proposed unit will contribute more or less equally to 2 production. 3 With that, I would move the admission of 4 5 Exhibits 1 and 2. EXAMINER DAWSON: Any objections? 6 7 MR. CARR: No objection. 8 MR. BRUCE: No objection. 9 EXAMINER DAWSON: At this point Exhibits 1 and 2 will be admitted to the record. 10 11 (Mewbourne Oil Company Exhibit Numbers 1 and 2 are offered and admitted into 12 13 evidence.) MS. HARDY: I would ask that the case be 14 taken under advisement. 15 16 EXAMINER DAWSON: Do you have any questions, David? 17 EXAMINER BROOKS: Yeah. This is a federal 18 19 lease, it looks like? 20 MS. HARDY: Yes. 21 EXAMINER BROOKS: Are there any overrides? 22 MS. HARDY: We have authority to pool the overrides. 23 24 EXAMINER BROOKS: I'm sorry? 25 MS. HARDY: We have authority to pool the
