HARDY: Mewbourne's application seeks the pooling of all uncommitted interests in the Bone 14 Spring Formation in a standard 398.54-acre horizontal 15 16 spacing unit comprised of the north half of the north half of Section 3, the north half of the north half of 17 18 Section 4 and the north half of the northeast quarter of 19 Section 5, Township 20 South, Range 30 East in Eddy 20 County. The horizontal spacing unit will be dedicated to the Caballo Loco 5/3 B2BA Fed Com #3H well. 21 Exhibit 1 is a self-affirmed statement of 22 23 landman, Mitch Robb. The attachments to his affidavit 24 include a Midland Map identifying the horizontal spacing 25 unit, a chart of tract ownership, documents addressing

Mr. Robb's well proposals, a notice of today's hearing 1 and an AFE for the well. As Mr. Robb notes in his 2 affidavit, there are no depth severances in the Bone 3 Spring Formation. Mewbourne is requesting overhead and 4 administrative rates of 8,000 a month and 800 a month, 5 6 which are the same as the rates in Mewbourne's JOA for 7 the well. And finally, Mewbourne is requesting a 200 8 percent risk penalty.

Exhibit Number 2 is a self-affirmed 9 10 statement of geologist Charles Crosby. Attached to 11 Mr. Crosby's affidavit are a structure map of the base of the Bone Spring Sand, a gross sand isopach map, a 12 west-to-east cross section, a table containing 13 information from other wells drilled in the vicinity and 14 a survey calculation report for the proposed well. As 15 16 stated in Mr. Crosby's affidavit, the horizontal spacing unit is justified from a geologic standpoint. A 17 18 west-to-east or east-to-west orientation is preferred. 19 There was no faulting or other geologic impediments that 20 might adversely affect the drilling of the proposed well, and each quarter section of the proposed unit will 21 22 contribute more or less equally to production. 23 With that, I would move the admission of 24 Exhibits 1 and 2. 25 EXAMINER DAWSON: Any objection?
