This matter came on for hearing before the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division, William V. Jones, Chief Examiner, and David K. Brooks, Legal Examiner, on Thursday, June 13, 2019, at the New Mexico Energy, Minerals and Natural Resources Department, Wendell Chino Building, 1220 South St. Francis Drive, Porter Hall, Room 102, Santa Fe, New Mexico.

- 2 EXAMINER JONES: Call Case Number 20548,
- 3 which is application of OXY USA, Incorporated for
- 4 compulsory pooling, Eddy County, New Mexico.
- 5 Call for appearances.
- 6 MS. LUCK: Kaitlyn Luck, with the Santa Fe
- 7 office of Holland & Hart.
- 8 And in front of you, I've placed all the
- 9 exhibits for all the cases I'll be presenting shortly.
- 10 EXAMINER JONES: The Refried Beans are
- 11 separate? You'll do them separate?
- MS. LUCK: Yeah. They're two separate
- 13 spacing units, so we're presenting them separately.
- In Case Number 20548, OXY is seeking an
- 15 order pooling all uncommitted interests in the Bone
- 16 Spring Formation underlying a standard 560-acre
- 17 horizontal spacing unit. This includes the Pierce
- 18 Crossing; Bone Spring, East Pool, pool code 96473. The
- 19 spacing unit is comprised of the south half of the north
- 20 half and the north half of the south half of Section 15
- 21 and the southeast quarter of the northeast quarter, the
- 22 south half of the northeast quarter, the northeast
- 23 quarter of the southwest quarter and the north half of
- 24 the southeast quarter of Section 16, Township 24 South,
- 25 Range 29 East, Eddy County, New Mexico.

1 In support of this case, OXY presents the

- 2 testimony of Jeremy Murphrey, who is a petroleum
- 3 landman. His credentials have been accepted and made a
- 4 matter of record as a petroleum landman. He's familiar
- 5 with this application.
- 6 Behind his affidavit is Exhibit 1, which is
- 7 a plat showing the tract of land comprising the proposed
- 8 horizontal spacing unit.
- 9 Exhibit A2 is the C-102 for the well that
- 10 has not yet been approved. It does show the bottom-hole
- 11 and surface-hole locations for this well -- and I
- 12 apologize -- for these wells. And the two wells are the
- 13 Refried Beans CC 15-16 State Com 12H well and the 13H
- 14 well. The 13H well will be a proximity tract well
- 15 pulling in the proximity tracts to create a standard
- 16 560-acre horizontal spacing unit that complies with the
- 17 statewide setbacks.
- 18 Exhibit A3 identifies the ownership in the
- 19 proposed spacing unit and the tracts of land. OXY is
- 20 only seeking to pool the highlighted record title
- 21 owners, and OXY has been able to locate an address for
- 22 each of these interest owners. A well-proposal letter
- 23 was provided, and the costs reflected in the AFE are
- 24 consistent with what OXY and other operators have
- 25 charged for similar wells. There are no depth

1 severances. And OXY has estimated its overhead and

- administrative costs at 7,500 and \$750 per month.
- And behind Exhibit B, OXY presents the
- 4 testimony of Tony J. Troutman, who is the petroleum
- 5 geologist for this case. He has also been accepted by
- 6 the Division as an expert in petroleum geology. These
- 7 wells are targeting the 1st Bone Spring Sand underlying
- 8 the proposed spacing unit.
- 9 Exhibit B1 is a structure map prepared for
- 10 the Bone Spring target interval, contour lines every 25
- 11 feet. The wellbore paths are noted in Sections 15 and
- 12 16.
- B2 identifies the two sets of wells used to
- 14 construct stratigraphic cross sections. There are two
- 15 separate stratigraphic cross sections, one from the
- 16 northwest to the southeast and then one from the west to
- 17 the east. And you'll see those two shown on OXY Exhibit
- 18 B2. There's the two separate lines, A to A prime, in
- 19 pink or red, and B to B prime is in green.
- 20 The logs for that stratigraphic cross
- 21 section are behind Exhibit B3 and demonstrates that the
- 22 target interval is present and continuous across the
- 23 subject acreage. Mr. Troutman also testifies the
- 24 east-to-west orientation for the proposed wells in the
- 25 Bone Spring target intervals is consistent and will

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1 appropriately and efficiently develop the target
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- 2 interval. His geologic study has concluded that each
- 3 tract within the horizontal spacing unit will contribute
- 4 more or less equally and the granting of the application
- 5 is in the best interest of conservation, the prevention
- of waste and the protection of correlative rights.
- 7 And then finally, Exhibit C is an affidavit
- 8 from our office stating that notice of the hearing was
- 9 provided to the record title owners that OXY seeks to
- 10 pool in these proceedings. And behind it are also the
- 11 delivery confirmations from the U.S. Postal Service.
- 12 So with that, OXY would request that
- 13 Exhibits A, B and C and the accompanying attachments be
- 14 admitted into the record in Case Number 20548.
- 15 EXAMINER JONES: Exhibits A, B and C and
- 16 their accompanying attachments are admitted in Case
- 17 20548.
- 18 (OXY USA, Inc. Exhibits A, B and C are
- 19 offered and admitted into evidence.)
- MS. LUCK: Thank you.
- 21 EXAMINER JONES: Case 20548 is taken under
- 22 advisement.
- MS. LUCK: Thank you.
