- MS. BENNETT: Actually, this case was
- 14 continued for two reasons, the first reason being that
- 15 when we arrived at the hearing the day that it was set,
- 16 we were told that this case not going to be heard, even
- 17 though I had witnesses here and I was prepared to go.
- 18 And there was a decision made to allow us to go forward
- 19 with this case, but it was continued by Mr. Brooks to
- 20 try to figure out who -- or why the case was designated
- 21 as continued when none of the parties had asked for it
- 22 to be continued. So I am assuming, perhaps incorrectly,
- 23 that given the lapse of time, we can overcome that
- 24 hurdle, because this case has been continued now, I
- 25 think, for 30 or 45 days to try to figure that out on

- 1 OCD's side.
- So assuming that that's not a hurdle, the
- 3 other reason it was -- or during that time of the
- 4 continuance, BC&D was protesting this well, and BC&D
- 5 agreed to provide additional information to the Division
- 6 in some information requests that were made during that
- 7 hearing. And subsequent to the hearing or after the
- 8 hearing, BC&D withdrew its protest and emailed that to
- 9 the Division. And I have copies of that email if anyone
- 10 would like to see it. But BC&D has formally withdrawn
- 11 its protest, and Mr. Larson is here today if you need
- 12 any confirmation of that.
- 13 And so at this point, in my mind, Cobra --
- 14 I'm sorry. Not Cobra -- oh, yeah. Cobra 1 is complete,
- 15 and I would ask that at this time it be taken under
- 16 advisement, as I don't see any outstanding notice
- issues, and BC&D's protest has been resolved.
- 18 EXAMINER GOETZE: Very good. With that, we
- 19 will go ahead -- and, of course, everything has been
- 20 processed according to the amended location; is that
- 21 correct?
