- 2 EXAMINER GOETZE: The next case is Case
- 3 20140, application of the NGL Water Solutions Permian,
- 4 LLC to approve a saltwater disposal well in Eddy County,
- 5 New Mexico.
- 6 Call for appearances.
- 7 MS. BENNETT: Good morning. Deana Bennett
- 8 on behalf of NGL Water Solutions Permian, LLC.
- 9 EXAMINER GOETZE: And our request was about
- 10 contacting the City of Carlsbad and giving them the
- 11 opportunity to take a look at the application.
- MS. BENNETT: That's right. And we have
- 13 not yet had a chance to do that, so I'm here today just
- 14 to give you a status update on that process and also to
- 15 request, to the extent this is a viable request, that
- 16 this case be taken off of the continuance docket but
- 17 that I be allowed to give you updates -- periodic
- 18 updates as we have them. And I did talk to Andrea
- 19 Antillon, at the State Land Office, yesterday who has
- 20 entered an appearance in this case, and she was fine
- 21 with me proposing that this case be taken off the
- 22 continuance docket so long as I agree to give updates to
- 23 all the parties that have entered their appearance in
- 24 this case.
- 25 And I think under the circumstances, that

1 makes sense both from OCD's perspective and from our

- 2 perspective. Rather than each month continuing this
- 3 case, letting us take this case off the docket while I
- 4 pursue those conversations with the City of Carlsbad
- 5 rather than -- and then give you updates rather than
- 6 having it be on the continuance docket, only to have me
- 7 every month come in or and give you the status update or
- 8 every month have to continue a case just because it's on
- 9 here as a placeholder.
- 10 So that would be my proposal, is that it
- 11 come off the continuance docket, but I be required to
- 12 give you status updates at your pleasure, every month,
- 13 every two months.
- 14 EXAMINER GOETZE: Well, what happens if the
- 15 City of Carlsbad wishes to have the opportunity to
- 16 present something? What do we do?
- 17 MS. BENNETT: We would then -- I guess I
- 18 would notify the Division that the City of Carlsbad
- 19 wants to say something, and we would come to hearing.
- 20 But then, you know, I don't want to just keep it on the
- 21 docket indefinitely. You know, moving it every month
- 22 just doesn't seem beneficial for you or beneficial for
- 23 me. I'd rather leave it as between us and on the
- 24 record. And say if the City of Carlsbad has an issue
- 25 and they want to come in and contest it, we would do

1 whatever it takes to set a hearing for that process to

- 2 occur.
- 3 EXAMINER GOETZE: How about we move it out
- 4 a significant amount of time --
- 5 MS. BENNETT: Okay. Sounds good.
- 6 EXAMINER GOETZE: -- and that way we keep
- 7 your place? We would initiate that continuance;
- 8 therefore, there would be no fee requirement or anything
- 9 like that, and we keep it in the books and such. And
- 10 we've done this with other applicants, where we've gone
- 11 forward and approved through administrative process and
- 12 just let them dismiss the case. I think that would
- 13 probably be a better saving for you and your case, and
- 14 then we won't get into this mumbo jumbo that legally
- 15 could be much more of a headache.
- MS. BENNETT: Okay.
- 17 EXAMINER GOETZE: So with that in mind --
- 18 EXAMINER JONES: Wait. There are dates:
- 19 September 19th and October 17th and August 22nd.
- MS. BENNETT: How about --
- 21 EXAMINER GOETZE: October?
- MS. BENNETT: Yeah, October.
- 23 EXAMINER JONES: October 17th.
- 24 MS. BENNETT: Uh-huh. And just for my own
- 25 clarification, let's say we get to October 15th and we

- 1 still don't have a resolution with the City --
- 2 EXAMINER GOETZE: Well, we are in the City
- of Carlsbad, and we are obligated to them. So this is
- 4 an impasse. So we've still got to talk to them, and
- 5 they've still got to know.
- 6 MS. BENNETT: Definitely.
- 7 EXAMINER GOETZE: With this location comes
- 8 a certain criteria that they need to be satisfied, and
- 9 we understand that. And so we're willing to work with
- 10 NGL to go forward with it, but they do have to have the
- 11 opportunity. We've already been through an embarrassing
- 12 series of situations --
- MS. BENNETT: Uh-huh.
- 14 EXAMINER GOETZE: -- and so we would like
- 15 to limit our next exposure.
- MS. BENNETT: Okay.
- 17 EXAMINER GOETZE: We understand, and we'll
- 18 press forward. Okay?
- MS. BENNETT: Great. Thank you.
- 20 EXAMINER JONES: As far as the continuance
- 21 fee?
- 22 EXAMINER GOETZE: We would waive that.
- 23 EXAMINER JONES: You want to waive it?
- 24 Okay.
- 25 EXAMINER GOETZE: It is a requirement. So

Page 7 we'll go ahead and do this internally. MS. BENNETT: Thank you. 2 3 And as I read the frequently asked questions on the website about the fee portal, that does 4 seem consistent with the frequently asked questions that 5 does say if the Division sets a continuance or a hearing 6 7 date, then there is no fee. 8 EXAMINER JONES: Okay. 9 EXAMINER GOETZE: We frequently ask 10 questions. It's very painful. 11 MS. BENNETT: Yeah (laughter). 12 EXAMINER GOETZE: And so Case Number 20140 13 is continued to October 17th; is that correct? 14 EXAMINER JONES: Yes. 15 MS. BENNETT: Thank you.
