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STATEMENT OF THE CASE

Applicant in the above-styled cause seeks an order pooling all uncommitted interests in the Wolfcamp formation, Dogie Draw; Wolfcamp Pool (Pool code 17980), underlying a standard 960-acre, more or less, horizontal spacing unit comprised of the W/2E/2 and W/2W/2 of Sections 14 and 23, Township 25 South, Range 35 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. COG Operating LLC seeks to dedicate the above-referenced horizontal spacing unit to the following proposed wells:

- The **Tin Foil Fed Com #604H** well to be horizontally drilled from a surface hole location in the SW/4SE/4 (Unit O) of Section 23 to a bottom hole location in the NW/4NE/4 (Unit B) of Section 14,
- The **Tin Foil Fed Com #705H** well to be horizontally drilled from a surface hole location in the SW/4SW/4 (Unit M) of Section 23 to a bottom hole location in the NW/4NW/4 (Unit D) of Section 14.

The completed interval for the proposed **Tin Foil Fed Com #604H** will be within 330' of the quarter-quarter line separating the W/2E/2 and the E/2W/2 of Sections 23 and 14, and the completed interval for the proposed **Tin Foil Fed Com #705H** will be within 330' of the quarter-quarter line separating the W/2W/2 and the E/2W/2 of Sections 23 and 14, which allow inclusion of this acreage into a standard 960-acre, more or less, horizontal spacing unit.

Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing said wells and the allocation of the cost thereof as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of COG Operating LLC as operator of the wells and a 200% charge for risk involved in drilling the wells. Said area is located Approximately 10 miles west of Jal, New Mexico.
