APPLICATION

SEP Permian, LLC ("Spur") (OGRID No. 338479), through its undersigned attorneys, hereby files this application with the Oil Conservation Division to amend Order R-20411 to add an additional well to the approved horizontal spacing unit. In support of its application, Spur states:

1. Division Order No. R-20411, entered February 26, 2019, in Case No. 20187, created a 160-acre, more or less, standard horizontal oil spacing unit in the N. Seven Rivers; Glorieta-Yeso Pool (Pool Code 97565), comprised of the W/2 E/2 of Section 34, Township 19 South, Range 25 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

2. The Order dedicated the above-described spacing unit to the proposed initial Lakewood Fed Com #4H Well (API No. 30-015-45669), to be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the SW/4 SE/4 (Unit O) of Section 27, to a bottom hole location in the SW/4 SE/4 (Unit O) of Section 34.

3. Since entry of Order No. R-20411, Spur, as successor operator to Percussion Petroleum, LLC, has determined that prior to the commencement of drilling it is prudent to add the following additional well to the approved spacing unit: The Lakewood Fed Com #8H Well

BEFORE THE OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION

(API No. 30-015-45676) to be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the SW/4 SE/4 (Unit O) of Section 27, to a bottom hole location in the SW/4 SE/4 (Unit O) of Section 34.

5. Spur has submitted a revised well proposal letter to the mineral owners pooled under Division Order No. R-20411 and will further notify them of this hearing.

WHEREFORE, Spur requests that this application be set for hearing before an Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on February 6, 2020, and, after notice and hearing as required by law, the Division amend Division Order No. R-20411 to add the well identified herein to the approved horizontal well spacing unit.

AFFIDAVIT OF STAN MITCHELL IN SUPPORT OF CASE NO. 21023 (ORDER NO. R-20411)

Stan Mitchell, of lawful age and being first duly sworn, declares as follows:

- 1. My name is Stan Mitchell. I work for Spur Energy Partners, LLC, an affiliate of SEP Permian, LLC, ("Spur") as a Contract Senior Landman.
- 2. I am familiar with the application filed by Spur in this case and familiar with the status of the lands in the subject area.
- 3. I do not anticipate any opposition to Spur's requested amendment of Order No. R-20411 in this case and presenting it by affidavit.
 - 4. This case was initially presented to the Division on January 10, 2019.
- 5. Division Order No. R-20411, entered February 28, 2019, in Case No. 20187, created a 160-acre, more or less, standard horizontal oil spacing unit in the N. Seven Rivers; Glorieta-Yeso Pool (Pool Code 97565), comprised of the W/2 E/2 of Section 34, Township 19 South, Range 25 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico. The Order dedicated the above-described spacing unit to the proposed initial **Lakewood Fed Com #4H Well** (API No. 30-015-45669), to be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the SW/4 SE/4 (Unit O) of Section 27, to a bottom hole location in the SW/4 SE/4 (Unit O) of Section 34.

- 6. Division Order No. R-20411 is attached as **Spur Exhibit C-1**.
- 7. Spur seeks an order to amend Order No. R-20411 to add additional wells to the approved horizontal spacing unit.
- 8. Since entry of Order No. R-20411, Spur, as successor operator to Percussion Petroleum, LLC, has determined that prior to the commencement of drilling it is prudent to add the following additional well to the approved spacing unit: The **Lakewood Fed Com #8H Well** (API No. 30-015-45676) to be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the SW/4 SE/4 (Unit O) of Section 27, to a bottom hole location in the SW/4 SE/4 (Unit O) of Section 34.
- 9. **Spur Exhibit C-2** is an in-house plat and spreadsheet reflecting the footage locations and the completed interval of the **Lakewood Fed Com #8H well**. The well is located in the N. Seven Rivers; Glorieta-Yeso Pool (Pool Code 97565).
- 10. The completed interval for the Lakewood Fed Com #8H well will comply with the Statewide setback requirements for oil wells.
- 11. Other than the addition of the initial well, all other provisions of Order No. R-20411 remain unchanged.
- 12. **Spur Exhibit C-3** contains a plat outlining the pooled unit, identifies the tracts of land comprising the pooled unit, and identifies the mineral interests pooled under Order No. R-20411. There are no depth severances in this Unit.
- 13. Spur sent a well proposal letter to the working interest owners for each of these proposed initial wells. An AFE for each well was included with the well proposal letter. The costs reflected in the AFE are consistent with what other operators have incurred for drilling similar horizontal wells in the area. A copy of the well proposal letter, along with the AFE, is attached as **Spur Exhibit No. C-4**.

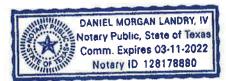

This case came on for hearing at 8:15 a.m. on January 10, 2019, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner William V. Jones. This case was again heard on January 24, 2019 and at that date taken under advisement.

NOW, on this 28th day of February, 2019, the Division Director, having considered the testimony, the record and the recommendations of the Examiner,

FINDS THAT

- (1) Due public notice has been given and the Division has jurisdiction of this case and the subject matter.
- (2) Cases No. 20187, 20188, and 20189 were consolidated at the hearing for testimony; however, a separate order will be issued for each case.
- (3) The Applicant, Percussion Petroleum Operating, LLC, seeks to compulsory pool all uncommitted oil and gas interests within a spacing unit ("the Unit") described as follows:

A Horizontal Spacing Unit comprising 160 acres (more or less) within the N. Seven Rivers; Glorieta-Yeso Pool (Pool code 97565) and all other pools hereafter defined within the Glorieta-Yeso formation in the W/2 E/2 of Section 34, Township 19 South, Range 25 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

(4) The Unit will be dedicated to the following well(s):

Lakewood Federal Com Well No. 4H, API No. 30-015-45669

- (5) The N. Seven Rivers; Glorieta-Yeso Pool is governed by Division Rule 19.15.15.9(A) NMAC, which specifies 40-acre spacing and proration units [vertical wells], each comprising a governmental quarter-quarter section.
- (6) The allowed setback footage distance for the proposed horizontal Oil well(s) is specified in Paragraph (1) of Subsection C of 19.15.16.15 NMAC effective June 26, 2018. Said rules allow the first or last take points to be no closer than 100 feet to the nearest unit boundary, and the setbacks measured perpendicular to the well path to be a minimum of 330 from the outer boundary of the horizontal spacing unit.
- (7) Challenger Crude Limited appeared at the hearing but did not oppose the case. No other party entered an appearance in this case or otherwise opposed this application.
- (8) Applicant appeared at the hearing through counsel and presented evidence to the effect that:
 - (a) The Glorieta-Yeso formation in this area is suitable for development by horizontal drilling.
 - (b) The orientation of the horizontal well(s) and the Unit is appropriate for optimum recovery of oil and gas.
 - (c) The target drilling depth will be within the Yeso member of the Glorieta-Yeso formation.
 - (d) Notice by certified mail was provided to all uncommitted interest owners in the proposed Unit whose interests were evidenced by a conveyance instrument, either of record or known to Applicant when the Application was filed, and to heirs known to Applicant of deceased persons who appear as owners in such instruments.
 - (e) Notice to affected parties who may have not been noticed otherwise was posted in a newspaper of general circulation in the county as provided in Rule 19.15.4.12.B NMAC.

The Division finds and concludes that

- (9) If the location of any of the Well(s) is unorthodox when the well is completed under the spacing rules then in effect and applicable to the well, the operator must obtain a non-standard location approval prior to producing the well.
- (10) Percussion Petroleum Operating, LLC (OGRID 371755) should be designated the operator of the Well(s) and of the Unit.
- (11) Two or more separately owned tracts are embraced within the Unit, and/or there are royalty interests and/or undivided interests in oil and gas minerals in one or more tracts included in the Unit that are separately owned.
- Applicant is owner of an oil and gas working interest within the Unit. Applicant has the right to drill and proposes to drill the Well(s) to a common source of supply within the Unit at the described depths and location(s). Applicant should be allowed a one year period to complete at least one of the Well(s) after commencing drilling of the Well(s).
- (13) There are interest owners in the Unit that have not agreed to pool their interests.
- (14) To avoid the drilling of unnecessary wells, protect correlative rights, prevent waste and afford to the owner of each interest in the Unit the opportunity to recover or receive without unnecessary expense a just and fair share of hydrocarbons, this application should be approved by pooling all uncommitted interests, whatever they may be, in the oil and gas in the depths to be pooled within the Unit.
- (15) To ensure protection of correlative rights, any pooled working interest owner whose address is known, and who has elected to participate under the terms of this order should be notified before the Division grants any extension of the time provided herein for commencing drilling. Any such owner may file an application, with notice to the operator, requesting that the extension be denied.
- (16) Infill wells within the Unit should be subject to Division Rules 19.15.13.9 NMAC through 19.15.13.10 NMAC, and to the terms and conditions of this order.
- (17) Any pooled working interest owner who does not pay its share of estimated well costs of any well should have withheld from production from such well its share of reasonable well costs plus an additional 200% thereof as a reasonable charge for the risk involved in drilling the Well(s).
- (18) Reasonable charges for supervision (combined fixed rates) should be fixed at \$7000 per month, per well, while drilling and \$700 per month, per well, while producing, provided that these rates should be adjusted annually pursuant to the COPAS form titled "Accounting Procedure-Joint Operations."

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT

(1) All uncommitted interests, whatever they may be, in the oil and gas within the following described spacing unit ("the Unit") are hereby pooled:

A Horizontal Spacing Unit comprising 160 acres (more or less) within the N. Seven Rivers; Glorieta-Yeso Pool (Pool code 97565) and all other pools hereafter defined within the Glorieta-Yeso formation in the W/2 E/2 of Section 34, Township 19 South, Range 25 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

(2) The Unit shall be dedicated to the following "Well(s)":

Lakewood Federal Com Well No. 4H, API No. 30-015-45669

SHL: 500 feet from the South line and 1690 feet from the East line, (Unit O) of Section 27, Township 19 South, Range 25 East, NMPM.

BHL: 20 feet from the South line and 1686 feet from the East line, (Unit O) of Section 34, Township 19 South, Range 25 East, NMPM.

- (3) Percussion Petroleum Operating, LLC (OGRID 371755) is hereby designated the operator of the Well(s) and of the Unit.
- (4) If any of the Well(s) is completed at an unorthodox location under applicable rules in effect at the time such well is completed, the operator shall provide notice and apply administratively for a location exception prior to producing the well.
- (5) The operator of the Unit shall commence drilling the Well(s) on or before February 29, 2020 and shall thereafter continue drilling the Well(s) with due diligence to test the target formation at or about the proposed true vertical and measured depths.
- (6) In the event the operator does not commence drilling the Well(s) on or before the date provided in the foregoing paragraph, the compulsory pooling provision of this order shall be of no effect, unless the operator obtains a written time extension from the Division Director pursuant to a written request stating its reasons for such extension and attaching satisfactory evidence.
- (7) In the event the operator does not commence completion operations within one year after commencement of drilling operations pursuant to this order, then the compulsory pooling provisions of this order shall be of no effect unless operator obtains a written time extension from the Division Director pursuant to a written request stating its reasons for such extension and attaching satisfactory evidence.
- (8) The operator shall provide a copy of any request for extension of time to drill or complete any well filed with the Director pursuant to this order to each pooled working interest owner who has elected to participate in the drilling of any well that is the

subject of the request. Such copy shall be sent at the same time the request is sent to the Director.

- (9) Upon final plugging and abandonment of the Well(s) and any other well drilled on the Unit pursuant to Division Rule 19.15.13.9 NMAC, the pooled unit created by this order shall terminate unless this order has been amended to authorize further operations.
- (10) Infill wells within the Unit shall be subject to Division Rule 19.15.13.9 NMAC and to the terms and conditions of this order.
- (11) After pooling, uncommitted working interest owners are referred to as pooled working interest owners. ("Pooled working interest owners" are owners of working interests in the Unit, including unleased mineral interests, who are not parties to an operating agreement governing the Unit.) After the effective date of this order, the operator shall furnish the Division and each known pooled working interest owner in the Unit separate itemized schedules of estimated costs of drilling, completing and equipping each of the Well(s) ("well costs").
- (12) Within 30 days from the date the schedule of estimated well costs for any well is furnished, any pooled working interest owner shall have the right to elect to pay its share of estimated well costs to the operator in lieu of paying its share of reasonable well costs out of production as hereinafter provided. Payment shall be rendered within 90 days after expiration of the 30-day election period and any such owner who pays its share of estimated well costs as provided above for any well shall remain liable for operating costs but shall not be liable for risk charges to the extent computed based on costs of such well. Pooled working interest owners who do not elect to pay their share of estimated well costs, or who do not render timely payment to the operator, as provided in this paragraph shall thereafter be referred to as "non-consenting working interest owners."
- (13) The operator shall furnish the Division and each known pooled working interest owner (including non-consenting working interest owners) an itemized schedule of actual well costs of each well within 180 days following completion of the proposed well. If no objection to the actual well costs for any well is received by the Division, and the Division has not objected, within 45 days following receipt of the schedule for such well, the actual well costs shall be deemed to be the reasonable well costs. If there is an objection to actual well costs within the 45-day period, the Division will determine reasonable well costs for such well after public notice and hearing.
- (14) Within 60 days following determination of reasonable well costs for any well, any pooled working interest owner who has paid its share of estimated costs of such well in advance as provided above shall pay to the operator its share of the amount that reasonable well costs exceed estimated well costs and shall receive from the operator the amount, if any, that the estimated well costs it has paid for such well exceed its share of reasonable well costs.

- (15) The operator is hereby authorized to withhold the following costs and charges from each non-consenting working interest owner's share of production from each well:
 - (a) the proportionate share of reasonable well costs attributable to the non-consenting working interest owner; and
 - (b) as a charge for the risk involved in drilling the well, 200% of the above costs.
- (16) During the cost recovery period, the operator shall furnish to the Division and to each known non-consenting pooled working interest owner, annually, and within 90 days after payout occurs, a schedule of all revenues attributable to each proposed well, and all charges for supervision and operating costs charged against such revenues. Operating costs shall include all reasonable costs incurred for the maintenance and operation of the well, except for "well costs" reported pursuant to prior ordering paragraphs, that are properly chargeable to the joint account pursuant to COPAS procedures. If no objection to the operating costs is received by the Division, and the Division has not objected, within 45 days following receipt of any schedule, the costs shall be deemed to be the reasonable operating costs. If there is an objection to the accuracy or reasonableness of operating costs reported within the 45-day period, the Division will determine reasonable operating costs after public notice and hearing.
- (17) The operator shall distribute the costs and charges withheld from production, proportionately, to the parties who advanced the well costs for such well.
- (18) Reasonable charges for supervision (combined fixed rates) are hereby fixed at \$7000 per month, per well, while drilling and \$700 per month, per well, while producing, provided that these rates shall be adjusted annually pursuant to the COPAS form titled "Accounting Procedure-Joint Operations." The operator is authorized to withhold from production from each well the proportionate share of both the supervision charges and the actual expenditures required for operating of such well, not more than what are reasonable, attributable to pooled working interest owners.
- (19) Except as provided in the foregoing paragraphs, all proceeds from production from the Well(s) that are not disbursed for any reason shall be held for the account of the person or persons entitled thereto pursuant to the Oil and Gas Proceeds Payment Act (NMSA 1978 Sections 70-10-1 through 70-10-6, as amended). If not sooner disbursed, such proceeds shall be turned over to the appropriate authority as and when required by the Uniform Unclaimed Property Act (NMSA 1978 Sections 7-8A-1 through 70-8A-31, as amended).
- (20) Any unleased mineral interest shall be considered a seven-eighths (7/8) working interest and a one-eighth (1/8) royalty interest for allocating costs and charges

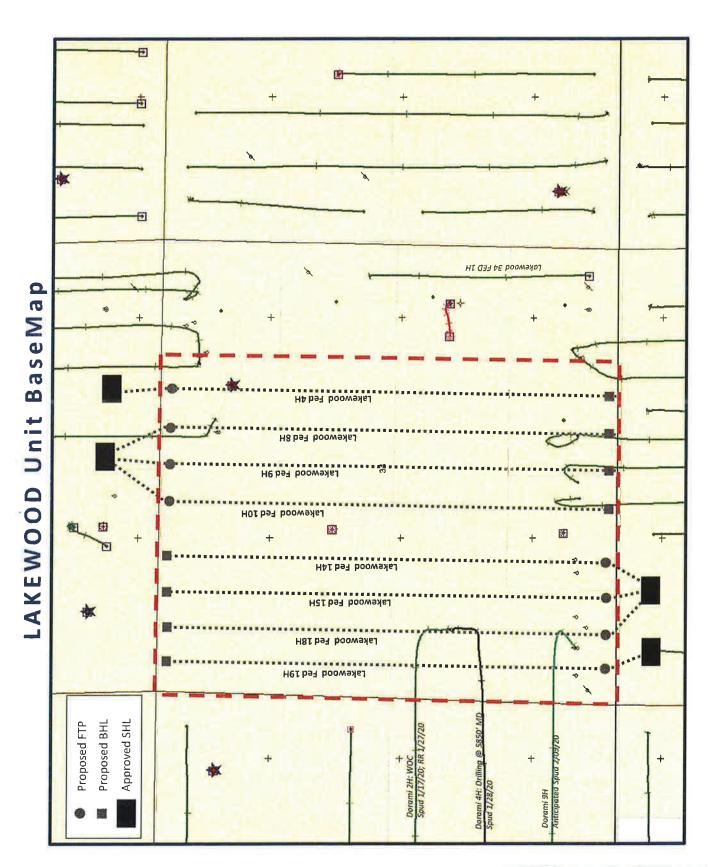

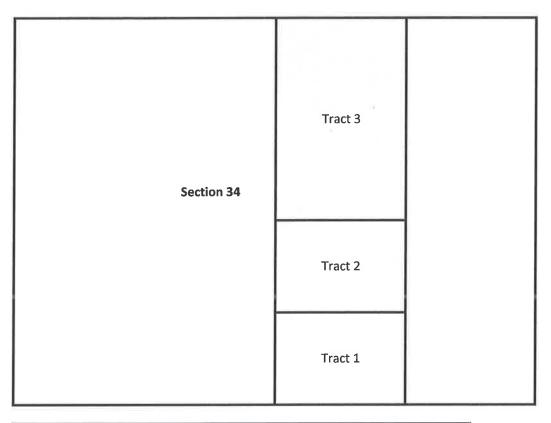

SEP Permian LLC ("SEP") as successor operator to Percussion Petroleum, LLC ("Percussion") by an Assignment, Bill of Sale, Deed and Conveyance, effective March 1, 2019, filed June 24, 2019 in Eddy County, NM County Clerk's Office in Book 1124, Page 918.

Prior to SEP's acquisition of Percussion's assets, Percussion sought and received approval from the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division ("OCD") to compulsory pool the above referenced lands. Enclosed for your reference is Compulsory Pooling Order R-20396 ("R-20396") which provides details of the pooled lands along with the terms and conditions to which the operator and pooled working interest owners are obligated.

SEP's subsurface and engineering teams have evaluated the original Lakewood Unit development plans contemplated by Percussion and believe in order to maximize hydrocarbon production in the most efficient and cost-effective manner developing the Lakewood Unit with a more substantial drilling program is necessary. Currently R-20396 limits SEP's proposed drilling program and SEP will seek to amend R-20396 with the OCD in order to address issues which currently prevent proposing, drilling and completing multiple wells per drilling pad, along with new borehole locations and horizontal lateral lengths. In addition to drilling multiple wells across the Lakewood Unit, SEP will request an extension of R-20396 of drilling by one (1) year. Currently R-20396 has a deadline of February 29, 2020. Upon the anticipated approval of this extension, SEP intends to re-propose and drill the new wells. Specific details to the new wells which will be proposed in 2020 are enclosed.

This case came on for hearing at 8:15 a.m. on January 10, 2019, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner William V. Jones. This case was again heard on January 24, 2019 and at that date taken under advisement.

NOW, on this 28th day of February, 2019, the Division Director, having considered the testimony, the record and the recommendations of the Examiner,

FINDS THAT

- (1) Due public notice has been given and the Division has jurisdiction of this case and the subject matter.
- (2) Cases No. 20187, 20188, and 20189 were consolidated at the hearing for testimony; however, a separate order will be issued for each case.
- (3) The Applicant, Percussion Petroleum Operating, LLC, seeks to compulsory pool all uncommitted oil and gas interests within a spacing unit ("the Unit") described as follows:

A Horizontal Spacing Unit comprising 160 acres (more or less) within the N. Seven Rivers; Glorieta-Yeso Pool (Pool code 97565) and all other pools hereafter defined within the Glorieta-Yeso formation in the W/2 E/2 of Section 34, Township 19 South, Range 25 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

(4) The Unit will be dedicated to the following well(s):

Lakewood Federal Com Well No. 4H, API No. 30-015-45669

SHL: 500 feet from the South line and 1690 feet from the East line, (Unit O) of Section 27, Township 19 South, Range 25 East, NMPM.

BHL: 20 feet from the South line and 1686 feet from the East line, (Unit O) of Section 34, Township 19 South, Range 25 East, NMPM.

- (5) The N. Seven Rivers; Glorieta-Yeso Pool is governed by Division Rule 19.15.15.9(A) NMAC, which specifies 40-acre spacing and proration units [vertical wells], each comprising a governmental quarter-quarter section.
- (6) The allowed setback footage distance for the proposed horizontal Oil well(s) is specified in Paragraph (1) of Subsection C of 19.15.16.15 NMAC effective June 26, 2018. Said rules allow the first or last take points to be no closer than 100 feet to the nearest unit boundary, and the setbacks measured perpendicular to the well path to be a minimum of 330 from the outer boundary of the horizontal spacing unit.
- (7) Challenger Crude Limited appeared at the hearing but did not oppose the case. No other party entered an appearance in this case or otherwise opposed this application.
- (8) Applicant appeared at the hearing through counsel and presented evidence to the effect that:
 - (a) The Glorieta-Yeso formation in this area is suitable for development by horizontal drilling.
 - (b) The orientation of the horizontal well(s) and the Unit is appropriate for optimum recovery of oil and gas.
 - (c) The target drilling depth will be within the Yeso member of the Glorieta-Yeso formation.
 - (d) Notice by certified mail was provided to all uncommitted interest owners in the proposed Unit whose interests were evidenced by a conveyance instrument, either of record or known to Applicant when the Application was filed, and to heirs known to Applicant of deceased persons who appear as owners in such instruments.
 - (e) Notice to affected parties who may have not been noticed otherwise was posted in a newspaper of general circulation in the county as provided in Rule 19.15.4.12.B NMAC.

The Division finds and concludes that

- (9) If the location of any of the Well(s) is unorthodox when the well is completed under the spacing rules then in effect and applicable to the well, the operator must obtain a non-standard location approval prior to producing the well.
- (10) Percussion Petroleum Operating, LLC (OGRID 371755) should be designated the operator of the Well(s) and of the Unit.
- (11) Two or more separately owned tracts are embraced within the Unit, and/or there are royalty interests and/or undivided interests in oil and gas minerals in one or more tracts included in the Unit that are separately owned.
- (12) Applicant is owner of an oil and gas working interest within the Unit. Applicant has the right to drill and proposes to drill the Well(s) to a common source of supply within the Unit at the described depths and location(s). Applicant should be allowed a one year period to complete at least one of the Well(s) after commencing drilling of the Well(s).
- (13) There are interest owners in the Unit that have not agreed to pool their interests.
- (14) To avoid the drilling of unnecessary wells, protect correlative rights, prevent waste and afford to the owner of each interest in the Unit the opportunity to recover or receive without unnecessary expense a just and fair share of hydrocarbons, this application should be approved by pooling all uncommitted interests, whatever they may be, in the oil and gas in the depths to be pooled within the Unit.
- (15) To ensure protection of correlative rights, any pooled working interest owner whose address is known, and who has elected to participate under the terms of this order should be notified before the Division grants any extension of the time provided herein for commencing drilling. Any such owner may file an application, with notice to the operator, requesting that the extension be denied.
- (16) Infill wells within the Unit should be subject to Division Rules 19.15.13.9 NMAC through 19.15.13.10 NMAC, and to the terms and conditions of this order.
- (17) Any pooled working interest owner who does not pay its share of estimated well costs of any well should have withheld from production from such well its share of reasonable well costs plus an additional 200% thereof as a reasonable charge for the risk involved in drilling the Well(s).
- (18) Reasonable charges for supervision (combined fixed rates) should be fixed at \$7000 per month, per well, while drilling and \$700 per month, per well, while producing, provided that these rates should be adjusted annually pursuant to the COPAS form titled "Accounting Procedure-Joint Operations."

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT

(1) All uncommitted interests, whatever they may be, in the oil and gas within the following described spacing unit ("the Unit") are hereby pooled:

A Horizontal Spacing Unit comprising 160 acres (more or less) within the N. Seven Rivers; Glorieta-Yeso Pool (Pool code 97565) and all other pools hereafter defined within the Glorieta-Yeso formation in the W/2 E/2 of Section 34, Township 19 South, Range 25 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

(2) The Unit shall be dedicated to the following "Well(s)":

Lakewood Federal Com Well No. 4H, API No. 30-015-45669

SHL: 500 feet from the South line and 1690 feet from the East line, (Unit O) of Section 27, Township 19 South, Range 25 East, NMPM.

BHL: 20 feet from the South line and 1686 feet from the East line, (Unit O) of Section 34, Township 19 South, Range 25 East, NMPM.

- (3) Percussion Petroleum Operating, LLC (OGRID 371755) is hereby designated the operator of the Well(s) and of the Unit.
- (4) If any of the Well(s) is completed at an unorthodox location under applicable rules in effect at the time such well is completed, the operator shall provide notice and apply administratively for a location exception prior to producing the well.
- (5) The operator of the Unit shall commence drilling the Well(s) on or before February 29, 2020 and shall thereafter continue drilling the Well(s) with due diligence to test the target formation at or about the proposed true vertical and measured depths.
- (6) In the event the operator does not commence drilling the Well(s) on or before the date provided in the foregoing paragraph, the compulsory pooling provision of this order shall be of no effect, unless the operator obtains a written time extension from the Division Director pursuant to a written request stating its reasons for such extension and attaching satisfactory evidence.
- (7) In the event the operator does not commence completion operations within one year after commencement of drilling operations pursuant to this order, then the compulsory pooling provisions of this order shall be of no effect unless operator obtains a written time extension from the Division Director pursuant to a written request stating its reasons for such extension and attaching satisfactory evidence.
- (8) The operator shall provide a copy of any request for extension of time to drill or complete any well filed with the Director pursuant to this order to each pooled working interest owner who has elected to participate in the drilling of any well that is the

subject of the request. Such copy shall be sent at the same time the request is sent to the Director.

- (9) Upon final plugging and abandonment of the Well(s) and any other well drilled on the Unit pursuant to Division Rule 19.15.13.9 NMAC, the pooled unit created by this order shall terminate unless this order has been amended to authorize further operations.
- (10) Infill wells within the Unit shall be subject to Division Rule 19.15.13.9 NMAC and to the terms and conditions of this order.

After the effective date of this order, the operator shall furnish the Division and each known pooled working interest owner in the Unit separate itemized schedules of estimated costs of drilling, completing and equipping each of the Well(s) ("well costs").
- (12) Within 30 days from the date the schedule of estimated well costs for any well is furnished, any pooled working interest owner shall have the right to elect to pay its share of estimated well costs to the operator in lieu of paying its share of reasonable well costs out of production as hereinafter provided. Payment shall be rendered within 90 days after expiration of the 30-day election period and any such owner who pays its share of estimated well costs as provided above for any well shall remain liable for operating costs but shall not be liable for risk charges to the extent computed based on costs of such well. Pooled working interest owners who do not elect to pay their share of estimated well costs, or who do not render timely payment to the operator, as provided in this paragraph shall thereafter be referred to as "non-consenting working interest owners."
- (13) The operator shall furnish the Division and each known pooled working interest owner (including non-consenting working interest owners) an itemized schedule of actual well costs of each well within 180 days following completion of the proposed well. If no objection to the actual well costs for any well is received by the Division, and the Division has not objected, within 45 days following receipt of the schedule for such well, the actual well costs shall be deemed to be the reasonable well costs. If there is an objection to actual well costs within the 45-day period, the Division will determine reasonable well costs for such well after public notice and hearing.
- (14) Within 60 days following determination of reasonable well costs for any well, any pooled working interest owner who has paid its share of estimated costs of such well in advance as provided above shall pay to the operator its share of the amount that reasonable well costs exceed estimated well costs and shall receive from the operator the amount, if any, that the estimated well costs it has paid for such well exceed its share of reasonable well costs.

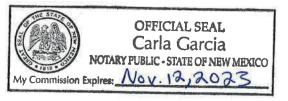
