STATEMENT OF THE CASE

APPLICANT

Case No. 21134: Kaiser-Francis Oil Company seeks an order pooling all mineral interests in the Bone Spring formation underlying a horizontal spacing unit comprised of the E/2 of Section 32, Township 23 South, Range 34 East, N.M.P.M. and Lots 1, 2, and the S/2NE/4 (the NE/4) of Section 5, Township 24 South, Range 34 East, N.M.P.M. The unit will be dedicated to (i) the Bell Lake Unit South Well No. 234H, with a first take point in the SW/4NE/4 of Section 5 and a last take point in the NW/NE/4 of Section 32, and (ii) the Bell Lake Unit South Well No. 236H, with a first take point in the SE/4NE/4 of Section 5 and a last take point in the NE/NE/4 of Section 32

Case No. 21134: Kaiser-Francis Oil Company seeks an order pooling all mineral interests in the Wolfcamp formation underlying a horizontal spacing unit comprised of the E/2 of Section 32, Township 23 South, Range 34 East, N.M.P.M. and Lots 1, 2, and the S/2NE/4 (the NE/4) of Section 5, Township 24 South, Range 34 East, N.M.P.M. The unit will be dedicated to (i) the Bell Lake Unit South Well No. 434H, with a first take point in the SW/4NE/4 of Section 5 and a last take point in the NW/NE/4 of Section 32, and (ii) the Bell Lake Unit South Well No.436H, with a first take point in the SE/4NE/4 of Section 5 and a last take point in the NE/NE/4 of Section 32.

Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the wells and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the wells, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the wells.
