Page 3 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: So I believe our final 1 affidavit cases are the next two, although the docket sheet 2 shows that a hearing was anticipated, as I understand it, 3 4 that may not be the case, so let's see. 5 21126 and 21127, Devon Energy, one relates to a well named Shetland 2, one relates to a well Shetland 1. I 6 7 have at least three intervenors enter appearances here. 8 MS. LUCK: Kaitlyn Luck with the Santa Fe office of Holland & Hart on behalf of the applicant in this case, 9 10 Devon Energy Production LP. HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Are you presenting one at 11 12 a time? MS. LUCK: I would like to present both of these 13 14 two cases together. 15 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Other appearances. MR. HOUGH: Lance half from from Modrall Sperling 16 17 on behalf of EOG Resources Inc. EOG doesn't have any 18 objection to the cases being taken by affidavit. Just one clarification I want to make, submitted 19 on behalf of EOG, a prehearing statement requesting some 20 modifications to language in the order. Our parties reached 21 a recent, agreement so we are withdrawing that agreement and 22 we are back to the standard order. 23 24 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Mr. Blanco. 25 MR. BLANCO: Andy Blanco with Hinkle Shanor I

Page 4 appearing on behalf of XTO. We don't have any objection to 1 2 the case being presented by affidavit. HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Do we have Mr. Fulson 3 4 present? 5 (No response.) 6 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Okay. Ms. Luck. 7 MS. LUCK: Thank you. And it's my understanding 8 that Devon was also able to reach a voluntary agreement with Mr. Fulson, so he was withdrawing his objection that he 9 10 previously filed. HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: All right. Thank you for 11 12 that. 13 MS. LUCK: And I also wanted to state on the 14 record it is also Devon's understanding that there is 15 voluntary agreement reached with EOG, and so we are asking there is not any additional or different terms included in 16 17 the pooling order. HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Okay, thank you. 18 So these two cases involve acreage in Sections 2 and 11, and in 19 Township 26 South, Range 31 East in Eddy County, New Mexico. 20 The first case 21126 relates to E/2 of the 21 section and the second case relates to the W/2. In both of 22 these cases Devon is seeking to pool standard spacing units 23 24 in the Purple Sage Wolfcamp in Eddy County and to dedicate 25 the spacing unit to several wells.

Before you I have presented the standard 1 So behind Tab C is the affidavit of Devon's 2 exhibits. landman, and then behind Tab D is the affidavit of Devon's 3 geologist. And then behind Tab E is a notice affidavit 4 5 reflecting that our office provided timely notice of this 6 hearing to the parties to be pooled. 7 There are also interest owner we are not sure we have addresses for so behind Tab F we provided a notice of 8 9 publication reflecting that notice was timely published of this hearing as well. 10 And I don't think there is any other issues out 11
