#### APPLICANT

Kaiser-Francis Oil Company seeks an order pooling all mineral interests in the Wolfcamp formation underlying a horizontal spacing unit comprised of the S/2 of Section 24, Township 23 South, Range 28 East, NMPM and Lots 3, 4, E/2SW/4, and SE/4 (the S/2) of Section 19, Township 23 South, Range 29 East, NMPM. The unit will be dedicated to the Brantley Fee 2419 WC Well No. 2H, with a first take point in the SW/4SW/4 of Section 24 and a last take point in the SE/4SE/4 of Section 19.
