WPX Energy Permian, LLC, formerly known as RKI Exploration & Production, LLC (collectively "WPX") files this application with the Oil Conservation Division pursuant to the provisions of N.M. Stat. Ann. § 70-2-17 for an order pooling all uncommitted interests in the Wolfcamp formation, Purple Sage Wolfcamp Gas Pool (Pool Code 98220), underlying a 636.35-acre standard horizontal spacing unit comprised of NE/4 of Section 35 and the N/2 of Section 36, both in Township 22 South, Range 28 East, NMPM, and Lot 1, Lot 2 and E/2 NW/4 of Section 31, Township 22 South, Range 29 East, NMPN, Eddy County, New Mexico. In support of its application, WPX states:

1. WPX (OGRID No. 246289) is a working interest owner in the proposed horizontal spacing unit and has the right to drill thereon.
2. WPX seeks to dedicate the above-referenced horizontal spacing unit to the following proposed wells:
 - The **Golden 35-22-28 Fed Com 401H** well to be drilled from a surface hole location in NW/4 NE/4 (Unit B) of Section 35 to a bottom hole location in the NE/4 NW/4 (Unit C) of Section 31; and
 - The **Golden 35-22-28 Fed Com 402H** well to be drilled from a surface hole location in NW/4 NE/4 (Unit B) of Section 35 to a bottom hole location in the SE/4 NW/4 (Unit F) of Section 31.

**AFFIDAVIT OF BRENNAN WEST
IN SUPPORT OF CASE NOS. 20374 & 20375**

Brennan West, of lawful age and being first duly sworn, declares as follows:

1. My name is Brennan West, and I am a Landman with WPX Energy Permian, LLC (“WPX”).
1. I have previously testified before the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division as an expert witness in petroleum land matters and my credentials have been accepted by the Division and made a matter of record.
2. I am familiar with the applications filed by WPX in these cases and the lands involved.
3. None of the overriding royalty interest owners to be pooled have expressed opposition to these cases proceeding by affidavit, so I do not expect any opposition at the hearing.
4. In Case No. 20374, WPX seeks an order pooling all uncommitted interests in the Wolfcamp formation (Purple Sage; Wolfcamp (Gas) Pool [98220]) formation underlying a 636.35-acre standard horizontal spacing unit comprised of NE/4 of Section 35, and the N/2 of Section 36, both in Township 22 South, Range 28 East, NMPM, and Lot 1, Lot 2 and E/2 NW/4 of Section 31, Township 22 South, Range 29 East, NMPN, Eddy County, New Mexico.
5. This standard horizontal spacing unit will be initially dedicated to the following two (2) proposed initial wells:

- The **Golden 35-22-28 Fed Com 401H** well to be drilled from a surface hole location in NW/4 NE/4 (Unit B) of Section 35 to a bottom hole location in the NE/4 NW/4 (Unit C) of Section 31; and
- The **Golden 35-22-28 Fed Com 402H** well to be drilled from a surface hole location in NW/4 NE/4 (Unit B) of Section 35 to a bottom hole location in the SE/4 NW/4 (Unit F) of Section 31.

6. **Exhibit C-1** contains the C-102s for these two proposed wells which are located in the Purple Sage; Wolfcamp (Gas) Pool [Pool Code 98220]. The completed intervals of these wells will comply with Special Rules for the Purple Sage Wolfcamp Pool.

7. In **Case No. 20375**, WPX seeks an order pooling all uncommitted interests in the Wolfcamp (Purple Sage; Wolfcamp (Gas) Pool [98220]) formation underlying a 633.85-acre standard horizontal spacing unit comprised of SE/4 of Section 35 and the S/2 of Section 36, both in Township 22 South, Range 28 East, NMPM, and Lot 3, Lot 4 and E/2 SW/4 of Section 31, Township 22 South, Range 29 East, NMPN, Eddy County, New Mexico.

8. This standard horizontal spacing unit will be initially dedicated to the following two (2) proposed initial wells:

- The **Retriever 35-22-28 Fed Com 401H** well to be drilled from a surface hole location in NW/4 SE/4 (Unit J) of Section 35 to a bottom hole location in the SE/4 SW/4 (Unit N) of Section 31; and
- The **Retriever 35-22-28 Fed Com 402H** well to be drilled from a surface hole location in NW/4 SE/4 (Unit J) of Section 35 to a bottom hole location in the NE/4 SW/4 (Unit K) of Section 31.

9. **Exhibit C-2** contains the C-102s for these two proposed wells which are located in the Purple Sage; Wolfcamp (Gas) Pool [Pool Code 98220]. The completed intervals of these wells will comply with Special Rules for the Purple Sage Wolfcamp Pool.

10. **Exhibit C-3** contains a plat outlining the units being pooled, identifies the tracts of land comprising the proposed spacing units, and identifies the overriding royalty interests in the

horizontal spacing units that remain to be pooled in these two cases. WPX has reached voluntary agreements with all of the working interest owners in the proposed units in **Case Nos. 20374 and 20375.**

11. There are no ownership depth severances in the Wolfcamp formation underlying the subject acreage in **Case Nos. 20374 and 20375.**

12. I have provided the law firm of Holland and Hart, LLP, with the names and addresses of the overriding royalty interest owners that WPX seeks to pool in **Case Nos. 20374 and 20375.** In compiling these addresses, I conducted a diligent search of the public records in Eddy County, New Mexico, where the wells are located, phone directories, and conducted computer searches to locate contact information for these parties.

13. Exhibits C-1 through C-3 were prepared by me or compiled under my direction from WPX's company business records.

AFFIDAVIT OF KEEGAN DePRIEST
IN SUPPORT OF CASE NOS. 20374 & 20375

Keegan DePriest, of lawful age and being first duly sworn, declares as follows:

1. My name is Keegan DePriest, and I work for WPX Energy Permian, LLC (“WPX”) as a geologist.

2. I have previously testified before the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division as an expert witness in petroleum geology matters and my credentials as an expert petroleum geologist have been accepted by the Division and made a matter of record.

3. I am familiar with the applications filed by WPX in these cases, and I have conducted a geologic study of the Wolfcamp formation underlying the subject acreage.

4. **Exhibit D-1** is a structure map for the top of the Wolfcamp formation, which also reflects the surrounding area in Eddy County in relation to Sections 35, 36, and 31 that comprise the spacing units in these cases. The completed intervals of the **Golden 35-22-28 Fed Com 401H and 402H wells** and the **Retriever 35-22-28 Fed Com 401H and 402H wells** are depicted with purple lines.

5. **Exhibit D-1** shows that the formation is gently dipping to the east in this area. I do not observe any other faulting, pinch outs, or geologic impediments to developing the targeted interval with horizontal wells.

6. **Exhibit D-2** identifies the four wells penetrating the targeted intervals that I used to construct a stratigraphic cross-section from A to A'. I utilized these well logs because they penetrate the targeted interval, are of good quality, and have been subjected to a petrophysical analysis of the targeted interval. In my opinion, these well logs are representative of the geology in the area.

7. **Exhibit D-3** is a stratigraphic cross section using the representative wells depicted on Exhibit D-2. It contains a gamma ray, resistivity and porosity logs. The target zone for the **Golden 35-22-28 Fed Com 401H and 402H wells** and the **Retriever 35-22-28 Fed Com 401H and 402H wells**, in the Wolfcamp X/Y, is labeled on the right side of the exhibit. The cross-section demonstrates that the targeted interval extends across the proposed spacing units.

8. **Exhibit D-4** is a gun barrel view of the development pattern for the **Golden 35-22-28 Fed Com 401H and 402H wells** and the **Retriever 35-22-28 Fed Com 401H and 402H wells** in the Wolfcamp X/Y targeted interval.

9. In my opinion, the laydown orientation of the wells is the preferred orientation for horizontal well development of the targeted interval in this area. This laydown orientation will efficiently and effectively develop the subject acreage in both spacing units proposed in **Case Nos. 20374 and 20375**.

10. Based on my geologic study, the targeted interval within the Wolfcamp formation underlying the subject area is suitable for development by horizontal wells and the tracts comprising the proposed spacing unit will contribute more-or-less equally to the production from the wellbores.

11. In my opinion, the granting of WPX's application will be in the best interest of conservation, the prevention of waste, and protection of correlative rights.

12. Exhibits D-1 through D-4 were either prepared by me or compiled under my direction and supervision.





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
