APPLICANT

Kaiser-Francis Oil Company seeks an order pooling all mineral interests from the top of the First Bone Spring Sand to the base of the Bone Spring formation in a (proximity tract) horizontal spacing unit comprised of Lots 1-4 and the E/2W/2 (the W/2) of Section 31, Township 25 South, Range 33 East, N.M.P.M. and Lots 1-4 and the E/2W/2 (the W/2) of Section 6, Township 26 South, Range 33 East, N.M.P.M. The unit will be dedicated to (i) the Red Hills Well Nos. 701H and 201H, with first take points in Lot 1 of Section 31 and last take points in Lot 4 of Section 6, and (ii) the Red Hills Well Nos. 703H and 203H, with first take points in the NE/4NW/4 of Section 31 and last take points in the SE/SW/4 of Section 6.
