1 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Let's move to case 21271.
2 The applicant is Kaiser-Francis, compulsory pooling matter
3 for the well named Red Hills. Mr. Bruce?

4 MR. BRUCE: Yes. Submitted by affidavit, the
5 package contains the application and proposed ad as Exhibit
6 1. Exhibits 2 and 3 are the landman's affidavit and
7 geologist affidavit. The landman, Mike Maxey, and the
8 geologist, Nick Sullivan, were previously qualified by the
9 Division as experts.

10 One thing I would note, I was not able to make
11 color copies of the geology attachments, if you would like
12 those, I can e-mail them in color to you. I couldn't print
13 them off.

14 It contains an affidavit of notice as Exhibit 4.

15 When you go through the package you will see that
16 COG Operating and Concho Oil & Gas were originally named as
17 pooled parties. They have come to terms with KFOC,
18 Kaiser-Francis, so they are not being pooled, they are
19 dismissed from the case. There are two other small interest
20 owners who are being pooled, and then the pooling checklist
21 is attached.

22 And with that, I would move the admission of the
