1 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Moving then to Matters 31
2 and 32 here, Case Numbers 21219 and 21220, COG Operating,
3 compulsory pooling application, well name Scout State.

4 We have Mr. Rodriguez, or is that you, Ms.
5 Munds-Dry, on behalf of COG?

6 MS. MUNDS-DRY: Thank you, Madam Examiner. Ocean
7 Munds-Dry on behalf of COG Operating LLC.

8 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: And, Mr. Bruce, are you
9 here for Mewbourne?

10 MR. BRUCE: I am.

11 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Thank you. I did not see
12 a prehearing statement filed on behalf of the applicant.
13 Ms. Munds-Dry?

14 MS. MUNDS-DRY: Thank you, Madam Examiner. We
15 have been conferring with Mewbourne with Mr. Bruce, and we
16 believe we have a joint stipulated proposal for you. I
17 guess we'll call it -- I'm not sure what we are calling it,
18 prehearing order where we have agreed to the date as
19 outlined in the April 22 notice contested hearing, in
20 addition to a range of dates between June 15 and June 30,
21 that -- that we have both checked to make sure our witnesses
22 are available.

23 So I think we are ready to, to give that to you.
24 We can send that to you by e-mail, as I'm understanding from
25 previous cases, for your review and then leave it to your

1 discretion to assess that hearing date.

2 So, no, we didn't submit prehearing statements
3 because Mr. Bruce and I both agreed that we would wait to,
4 to get your instruction on our hearing date.

5 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: All right. Thank you.
6 So if you would, please, I -- in the second half of June,
7 actually, most of my -- of my hearings were cleared from my
8 calendar, although now the June calendar is starting to
9 populate before the 15th of June.

10 So if you would, please, send me the prehearing
11 order in Word. And then looking at the other cases we will
12 be scheduling in June, we will decide on a specific date
13 after -- just identify those dates that are best for you
14 and those dates that might be out for you, and if necessary,
15 again we will get on the telephone in a, in a very brief
16 prehearing conference that way.

17 MS. MUNDS-DRY: Happy to do so, Madam Examiner.

18 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: All right. And also, is
19 there anyone who is still viewing this session handling any
20 (unclear audio) so helpful if you are able to provide even a
21 rough draft of how long you both view the hearing would go.

22 We are asking a lot of the lawyers, as you know,
23 with the contested matters with the full (unclear audio)
24 testimony being turned in beforehand ideally, then focusing
25 in the hearing primarily on cross-examination or rebuttal.

1 So considering all of the special concerns we are
2 going to be operating under, just give me your best estimate
3 as to how long you believe the hearing will go.

4 MS. MUNDS-DRY: One day.

5 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: All right. Thank you
6 very much, Ms. Munds-Dry. And Mr. Bruce?

7 MR. BRUCE: I have nothing further to add.

8 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Thank you.
