MOTION TO STRIKE OR IN THE ALTERNATIVE MOTION TO SUPPLEMENT THE RECORD

COG Operating LLC ("COG"), submits this motion to strike the language described below from Mewbourne Oil Company's ("Mewbourne") closing argument submitted on Friday, July 24, 2020. In the alternative, COG moves to supplement the record with the additional information and exhibits presented in this pleading. In support of its motion, COG states:

- 1. In its closing argument, Mewbourne states that: "Mewbourne sent valid proposals to COG under the JOA, and <u>COG has subsequently elected not to participate in Mewbourne's proposals</u>. Per the JOA, Mewbourne has to commence operations in a set amount of time following the proposals, and <u>Mewbourne is moving forward with its plan to develop the N/2 of Section 6."</u> Mewbourne's Closing Argument, pg. 2 (emphasis added).
 - 2. Evidence was taken and heard in Case Nos. 21219 and 21220 on June 26, 2020.
- 3. As noted during the hearing, Mewbourne proposed wells in the N/2 of Section 6 as a non-operator under a JOA in which COG is the designated operator. The election period for Mewbourne's well proposals in the N/2 of Section 6 ("Devon-6 wells") expired on July 17, 2020.
- 4. On July 16, 2020, COG requested an extension of the election period from Mewbourne because of these pending cases. Affidavit of Ashley Roush, ¶2.

5. Mewbourne refused to grant COG an extension on its Devon-6 well proposals even

though it granted OXY USA Inc. an extension. *Id.* at ¶3.

6. On July 17, COG informed Mewbourne that it would not participate in its proposed

wells because COG has already proposed its preferred development plan to Mewbourne and has

sought to pool Mewbourne's interest in Cases 21219 and 21220. Id. at ¶4.

7. These events, which took place twenty-one (21) days after Case Nos. 21219 and 21220

were heard, are post-hearing events occurring outside the scope of the evidence and testimony

presented at hearing.

8. In the alternative, COG moves to supplement the record with the additional information

and exhibits presented in this pleading.

9. WHEREFORE, COG respectfully requests that the Division grant its motion to strike

the language described above from Mewbourne's closing argument or supplement the record with the

evidence provided in this motion.

Ashley,

At this time we are not able to extend the election period under the Devon 6 Fee well proposals. As we have discussed for months, our goal is to work out a mutually agreeable trade with COG on the subject properties as opposed to using the OCD as a negotiation tool.

If we were collectively/actively working towards a resolution MOC would be able to work with COG on this request. However, to date we have not received any feedback or agreement to the trade COG offered MOC and we agreed to. I have made it clear that we are agreeable to executing a letter agreement with reasonable language incorporated in it, along the lines of what COG did with Devon. In this connection, I provided the paperwork for the trade we agreed to based on the previous forms negotiated between MOC and COG.

The OCD should be used as a last resort and not a mechanism to hinder working together. MOC is still willing and ready to work something out with COG based on what was previously discussed but it will take efforts from both sides.
