STATEMENT OF THE CASE

APPLICANT

Tap Rock Resources, LLC seeks an order pooling all mineral interests in the Wolfcamp formation underlying a horizontal spacing unit comprised of the E/2E/2 of Section 18 and the E/2E/2 of Section 19, Township 25 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. The unit will be dedicated Black Marlin Fed. Com. Well Nos. 204H, 214H, and 216H, to be

drilled to a depth sufficient to test the Wolfcamp formation. The wells have first take points in the NE/4NE/4 of Section 18 and last take points in the SE/4SE/4 of Section 19. Applicant seeks to dedicate the E/2E/2 of Section 18 and the E/2E/2 of Section 19 to the wells. The Black Marlin Fed. Com. Well No. 216H is at an unorthodox well location, being located 1210 feet from the east lines of Sections 18 and 19, and applicant requests approval of the location. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling, completing, and equipping the wells and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of Tap Rock Operating, LLC as operator of the wells, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling, completing, and equipping the wells.
