STATEMENT OF CASE

APPLICANT:

In Case No. 21444, Franklin seeks an order from the Division pooling all uncommitted mineral interests within a Wolfcamp horizontal spacing unit underlying the W/2 E/2 and the E/2 W/2 of Sections 1 and 12, and the NW/4 NE/4 and the NE/4 NW/4 of Section 13, Township 26 South, Range 35 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. Part of FME's 720-acre horizontal spacing unit will overlap an existing 240-acre spacing unit for the Wolfcamp formation, which is approved under Division Order R-14547 for the Ushanka Federal Com. Well No. 23H. Franklin's spacing unit will be dedicated to the **Kaston Fed Com 703H and the Bus Driver Fed Com 702H** wells, to be horizontally drilled. The completed interval for Kaston Fed Com 703H well will be within 330' from the adjoining tracts to allow inclusion of proximity tracts

within the proposed standard horizontal spacing unit. The producing area for the wells will be orthodox. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing said wells, the allocation of these costs as well as the actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of Franklin Mountain Energy, LLC as operator of the wells, and a 200% charge for risk involved in drilling said wells, and allowing a one year period between when the first well is drilled and when the wells are completed.
