**OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION'S
DOCKETING NOTICE**

The New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (“OCD”), pursuant to 19.15.5.10(E)(2)(a) NMAC, gives notice that it has docketed the Notice of Violation (“NOV”) attached as Exhibit A, and states the following in support thereof:

1. On December 14, 2020, OCD issued the NOV to Wespac Energy, LLC (“Wespac”).
2. The NOV, which is incorporated by reference, identifies the factual basis for the alleged violation, the compliance action required to remedy the alleged violation, and the proposed sanction.
3. The NOV states that if Wespac does not informally resolve the NOV within 30 days of receipt of service, then OCD will hold a hearing.
4. On December 14, 2020, OCD served the NOV on Wespac by certified and electronic mail at the addresses of record provided by Wespac to OCD.
5. OCD’s electronic mail to Wespac was not returned.
6. OCD’s certified mail to Wespac was not delivered or deliverable, and was returned to OCD.
7. As of the date of this pleading, Wespac has not contacted OCD.
8. A hearing on the NOV has been scheduled for March 3, 2021.
