- 3 now, for those of you just waking up, we are on Case 11,
- 4 and this would be Case 21586. I don't know if you are
- 5 going to combine that with 21587. And we are now on to
- 6 Smashing Pumpkins?
- 7 MS. BROGGI: Yes, Mr. Hearing Examiner.
- 8 Again, Julia Broggi with Holland & Hart on
- 9 behalf of the Applicant Spur Energy Partners, LLC.
- 10 We would like to combine both of the cases
- 11 21586 and 21587, and we would also like to present these
- 12 cases as consolidated cases by affidavit.
- 13 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you. I'll ask
- 14 for any other appearances or objections to filing by
- 15 affidavit.
- 16 Hearing none, you may proceed, Ms. Broggi.
- 17 MS. BROGGI: Mr. Examiner, these two cases are
- 18 somewhat similar to the Radiohead cases that we just
- 19 heard. In both cases we are seeking to pool the
- 20 uncommitted interest owners in the Yeso Formation in a
- 21 160-acre horizontal spacing unit comprised of the north
- 22 half of the south half of Section 18, Township 18 South,
- 23 Range 27 East, NMPM Eddy County, New Mexico.
- 24 And then in the first case, Case 21586 --
- 25 let me meet back up.

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- 1 There is a depth severance in this
- 2 formation, and in 21585 Spur Energy is seeking to pool all
- 3 uncommitted interests above that depth severance, and then
- 4 in Case 21587 Spur Energy is seeking to pool the
- 5 uncommitted interests below the depth severance.
- 6 The Division should have received an
- 7 exhibit packet, one exhibit packet for both these cases,
- 8 with the Table of Contents up at the front.
- 9 The Compulsory Pooling Application is
- 10 Exhibit A.
- The applications for both cases are found
- 12 at Exhibit B.
- 13 The affidavit of Megan Pena, who is the
- 14 landman who has testified in the prior Spur Energy Cases,
- 15 can be found at Exhibit C, with her corresponding land
- 16 exhibits.
- 17 And then once again just to orient
- 18 everybody, at paragraphs 5 and paragraphs 11 of Ms. Pina's
- 19 affidavit you will see where she lays forth the depth
- 20 severance.
- 21 So in the first Case, 21586, we are pooling
- 22 from the top of the Yeso Formation to a depth of 3,000
- 23 feet, and then in the other case, 21587, Spur Energy is
- 24 speaking to pool from a depth of 3,001 feet to the base of
- 25 the Yeso Formation.

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1 Then we have the affidavit of the geologist

- 2 which is found at Exhibit D, and the corresponding geology
- 3 exhibits.
- 4 Exhibit E is the Notice affidavit signed by
- 5 Kaitlyn Luck of my office showing that Notice of this
- 6 hearing was provided to all parties. Once again my
- 7 understanding is that all parties were locatable, but out
- 8 of an abundance of caution we also provided Notice by
- 9 Publication.
- 10 And the affidavit for Notice by Publication
- 11 can be found at Exhibit F.
- 12 And we would move the admission at this
- 13 point of Spur Exhibits A through Spur Exhibit F.
- 14 And I will stand for questions.
- 15 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you. Any
- 16 questions from the examiners?
- 17 EXAMINER ROSE-COSS: No questions at this time
- 18 from me. Thank you.
- 19 EXAMINER McCLURE: I have no questions at this
- 20 time.
- 21 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Okay. Are there any
- 22 comments? We have two cases in front of us, 21586 and
- 23 21587.
- Hearing none, then we will admit the
- 25 exhibits in these cases, consolidate them, and take cases
