Kaiser-Francis Oil Company seeks an order pooling all mineral interests in the Wolfcamp formation underlying spacing and proration unit in the Wolfcamp formation comprised of the SE/4 of Section 20 and the SW/4 of Section 21, Township 23 South, Range 28 East, NMPM. The unit will be dedicated to: (a) the Loving Townsite 2021 WC Well No. 1H, with a first take point in the NW/4SE/4 of Section 20 and a final take point in the NE/4SW/4 of Section 21; (b) the Loving Townsite 2021 WA Well No. 1H, a with a first take point in the NW/4SE/4 of Section 20 and a final take point in the NE/4SW/4 of Section 21; (c) the Loving Townsite 2021 WC Well No. 2H, well with a first take point in the SW/4SE/4 of Section 20 and a final take point in the SE/4SW/4 of Section 21; and (d) the Loving Townsite 2021 WA Well No. 2H, with a first take point in the SW/4SE/4 of Section 20 and a final take point in the SE/4SW/4 of Section 21. wells and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the wells, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling, completing, and equipping the wells.
