STATEMENT OF THE CASE

APPLICANT

Case No. 21724: Mewbourne Oil Company seeks an order pooling all mineral interests in the Wolfcamp formation underlying a horizontal spacing unit comprised of the N/2 of Section 23 and the N/2 of Section 24, Township 21 South, Range 27 East, NMPM. The unit will be dedicated to: (a) the Chile Verde W0DA 23/24 Fed. Com. Well No. 1H, a horizontal well with a first take point in the NW/4NW/4 of Section 23 and a last take point in the NE/4NE/4 of Section 24; and (b) the Chile Verde W0EH 23/24 Fed. Com. Well No. 1H, a horizontal well with a first take point in the SW/4NW/4 of Section 23 and a last take point in the SE/4NE/4 of Section 24.

<u>Case No. 21725</u>: Mewbourne Oil Company seeks an order pooling all mineral interests in the Wolfcamp formation underlying a horizontal spacing unit comprised of the S/2 of Section 23 and the S/2 of Section 24, Township 21 South, Range 27 East, NMPM. The unit will be dedicated to: (a) the Chile Verde W0LI 23/24 Fed. Com. Well No. 1H, a horizontal well with a first take point

in the NW/4SW/4 of Section 23 and a last take point in the NE/4SE/4 of Section 24; and (b) the Chile Verde W0MP 23/24 Fed. Com. Well No. 1H, a horizontal well with a first take point in the SW/4SW/4 of Section 23 and a last take point in the SE/4SE/4 of Section 24.

Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling, completing, and equipping the wells and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the wells, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the wells.
