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STATEMENT OF THE CASE

In **Case No. 21666**, Chevron seeks to amend Division Order No. R-21229 ("Order") to allow for an extension of time for completion of the CB CAL 25 36 State Com 08 #303H Well under the Order. Order No. R-21229, entered on April 2, 2020, in Case No. 21124, created a standard 320-acre horizontal spacing unit comprised of the E/2 W/2 of Sections 25 and 36,

Township 23 South, Range 28 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico (“Unit”), and designated Chevron as operator of the Unit. The Order further pooled the uncommitted interests in the Bone Spring formation (Culebra Bluff; Bone Spring, South Pool [Pool code 15011]) in the Unit, and dedicated the Unit to the **CB CAL 25 36 State Com 08 #301H Well**, and the **CB CAL 25 36 State Com 08 #303H Well**. Chevron commenced drilling the **CB CAL 25 36 State Com 08 #303H Well** on April 16, 2020, and now requests that Order No. R-21229 be re-opened and amended to allow Applicant additional time to commence completion of the **CB CAL 25 36 State Com 08 #303H Well** under the Order, for a year to April 16, 2022.


