**OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION'S
DOCKETING NOTICE**

The New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (“OCD”), pursuant to 19.15.5.10(E)(2)(a) NMAC, gives notice that it has docketed the Notice of Violation (“NOV”) attached as Exhibit A, and states the following in support thereof:

1. On January 27, 2021, OCD issued the NOV to Flare Oil, Inc. (“Flare”).
2. On February 3, 2021, the NOV was served on Flare’s registered agent by certified and electronic mail.
3. The NOV identified the factual basis for the alleged violations, the compliance action required to remedy the alleged violations, and the proposed sanctions.
4. The NOV stated that if Flare did not informally resolve the NOV within 30 days of receipt of service, then OCD would hold a hearing on May 5, 2021.
5. As of the date of this pleading, Flare has not contacted OCD and the NOV has not been informally resolved.
6. Due to administrative issues, OCD has determined that all hearings will be held on normally scheduled docket dates.

WHEREFORE, OCD requests that the NOV be docketed for hearing on May 6, 2021.
