STATEMENT OF THE CASE

APPLICANT

Case No. 21795: Applicant seeks an order pooling all mineral interest owners in the Bone Spring formation underlying a horizontal spacing unit comprised of the W/2E/2 of Section 3 and W/2E/2 of Section 10, Township 22 South, Range 32 East, NMPM. The unit will be dedicated to the Nina Cortell Well No. 127H, with a first take point in the SW/4SE/4 of Section 10 and a last take point in the NW/4NE/4 of Section 3.

Case No. 21796: Applicant seeks an order pooling all mineral interest owners in the Bone Spring formation underlying a horizontal spacing unit comprised of the E/2E/2 of Section 3 and E/2E/2 of Section 10, Township 22 South, Range 32 East, NMPM. The unit will be dedicated to the Nina Cortell Well No. 204H, with a first take point in the SE/4SE/4 of Section 10 and a last take point in the NE/4NE/4 of Section 3.

Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the wells and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the wells, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the wells.
