**OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION'S  
MOTION TO VACATE HEARING**

The New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (“OCD”) moves to vacate the hearing scheduled for April 21, 2021, and states the following in support thereof:

1. On February 23, 2021, OCD docketed the Notice of Violation (“NOV”) issued to Wespac Energy, LLC (“Wespac”).
2. The Docketing Notice stated that Wespac had failed to respond to the NOV and the informal resolution period had expired, and requested a hearing on March 3, 2021.
3. Shortly after being served the Docketing Notice, Wespac contacted OCD and requested additional time to correct the alleged violations.
4. On March 1, 2021, OCD moved to continue the hearing until April 21, 2021, to allow Wespac additional time to correct the alleged violations.
5. Since then, Wespac continues to make meaningful progress toward correcting the alleged violations.

WHEREFORE, OCD respectfully requests that the hearing scheduled for April 21, 2021 be vacated.
