- Leatherneck 3029 Fed Com #127H well (API No. 30-015-46894), which will be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the SW/4 SW/4 (Lot 4) of Section 30 to bottom hole location in the NE/4 SE/4 (Unit I) of Section 29; and
- Leatherneck 3029 Fed Com #137H well (API No. 30-015-46895), which will be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the NW/4 SW/4 (Lot 3) of Section 30 to bottom hole location in the NE/4 SE/4 (Unit I) of Section 29.
