**OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION'S
DOCKETING NOTICE**

The New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (“OCD”), pursuant to 19.15.5.10(E)(2)(a) NMAC, gives notice that it has docketed the Notice of Violation (“NOV”) attached as Exhibit A, and states the following in support thereof:

1. On March 17, 2021, OCD issued the NOV to Roger Slayton dba Escudilla Oil Company, OGRID #228270 (“Slayton”).
2. On March 17, 2021, the NOV was served electronically on Slayton.
3. The electronic mail transmitting the NOV was not returned.
4. On March 17, 2021, OCD served the NOV on Slayton by certified mail at his address of record.
5. On March 30, 2021, the U.S. Postal Service returned the NOV to OCD with the notation “Return to Sender – Vacant – Unable to Forward.”
6. The NOV identified the factual basis for the alleged violations, the compliance action required to remedy the alleged violations, and the proposed sanctions.
7. The NOV stated that if Slayton did not informally resolve the NOV within 30 days of receipt of service, then OCD would hold a hearing on June 3, 2021.
8. The period for informal resolution expired without resolution of the NOV.

WHEREFORE, OCD requests that the NOV be docketed for hearing on June 3, 2021.
