1 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Moving to cases 21691 and  
2 21692, Titus Oil & Gas, the applicant, request to amend  
3 orders. Love Shack is the name of the well. Ms. Shaheen,  
4 you are still here for the applicant, I take it?

5 MS. SHAHEEN: I am. Sharon Shaheen with  
6 Montgomery & Andrews on behalf of Titus Oil & Gas  
7 Production. In these cases we seek to amend Orders R-21320  
8 and R-21321, which were previously issued in Case Numbers  
9 21200 and 21201 to extend the time for drilling for Love  
10 Shack Fed Com wells. These were previously pooled in a 320  
11 acre unit comprised of the W/2 W/2 of Section 17, and the  
12 W/2 W/2 of Section 8, all in Township 26 South, Range 35  
13 East.

14 I believe these are both -- one is 21320, Order  
15 Number R-21230 is a Bone Spring well, and Order Number  
16 R-21321 is a Wolfcamp well. In this case -- in these cases  
17 as well, we did have a non-substantive error that was  
18 corrected in a subsequent order -- orders, R-23120-A and  
19 R-21321-A. Again, these revised orders incorporated the  
20 original orders, and we ask for no changes in the revised  
21 orders, only that the original orders be amended to extend  
22 the time for drilling to May 7, 2021 due to Covid market  
23 conditions and the federal executive order.

24 Unless anyone has questions -- did I say May 7,  
25 2022? I want to make sure because I typed it wrong. With

1 that, I ask the Division to admit these exhibits into the  
2 record, take the case under advisement and ultimately amend  
3 the orders to extend the time for drilling to May 7, 2022.

4 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Thank you, Ms. Shaheen.  
5 Mr. Lamkin, any questions?

6 TECHNICAL EXAMINER LAMKIN: No questions. Thank  
7 you.

8 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: All right. Thank you.
