- 7 think it would be fruitful just to continue these cases --
- 8 I forget. Mr. Feldewert mentioned a date and I was
- 9 agreeable to that -- to let the parties try to work things
- 10 out voluntarily.
- 11 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you.
- 12 Mr. Feldewert, did you have a date?
- MR. FELDEWERT: Yeah, Mr. Brancard. I mean, I
- 14 think this is one of those circumstances where we need a
- 15 date just to set, probably, a status conference.
- I think what I had suggested was either a
- 17 month or two, Jim. I can't remember.
- 18 MR. BRUCE: I think you had suggested two
- 19 months, and I was amenable to that.
- 20 MR. FELDEWERT: I think that's right. Yeah, I
- 21 think that makes a lot of sense. I would suggest a status
- 22 conference two months out, Mr. Brancard.
- 23 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you. Any other
- 24 comments from the other parties. Ms. Hardy?
- 25 MS. HARDY: No, Mr. Examiner. That's fine with

- 1 Advance.
- 2 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Ms. Munds-Dry?
- 3 MS. MUNDS-DRY: Sounds good to us. Thank you.
- 4 EXAMINER BRANCARD: All right. What are your
- 5 dates in October, Marlene?
- MS. SALVIDREZ: Give me one second.
- 7 MR. FELDEWERT: I'm going to beat you to it,
- 8 Marlene. Looks like the 7th and the 21st, I think.
- 9 MS. SALVIDREZ: Yes.
- 10 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Why don't we do October 7th?
- 11 MR. BRUCE: That's fine with me.
- MR. FELDEWERT: That makes sense, Mr. Brancard.
- 13 Thank you.
- 14 EXAMINER BRANCARD: And you're thinking status
- 15 conference?
- MR. FELDEWERT: I am, yes.
- 17 MR. BRUCE: Yes.
- 18 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Okay. All right. Then I
