RODRIGUEZ: Thank you. 11 12 In this matter, COG is requesting the Division amend Order No. R-21474 to extend the deadline to 13 14 commence drilling operations until one year from the date 15 the Amended Order is issued. 16 The Division issued Order No. R-21474 in 17 Case No. 21421 on September 21, 2020, and the Order created a 640-acre standard horizontal spacing unit within 18 the Wolfcamp, comprised of the west half of Sections 26 19 and 35, Township 23 South, Range 32 East, Lea County, New 20 21 Mexico, and designated COG the operator of the unit and 22 dedicate the unit to COG's Bedlington Federal Com 701, 702, 703 and 704H wells. Due to Covid 19 and commodity 23 24 prices, COG was required to revise its drilling schedule, 25 and now plans to drill these wells sometime in the fourth
