23 docket, and I have spoken with Mr. Bruce, and we agree
24 that all these cases should be set for a contested
25 hearing, and I think that the January 20th date would work

1 for COG if that works for Matador.

2 MR. BRANCARD: Thank you.

4 MR. BRUCE: Yeah, I'd have to double check, but
5 I'm sure that would work out fine.

6 MR. BRANCARD: All right. And does your other
7 client agree, Ms. Hardy.

8 MS. HARDY: Yes, Mr. Examiner.

9 MR. BRANCARD: Are there any other persons
10 interested in these Cases 22211 through 22218? (Note:
11 Pause.)
