On behalf of the applicant, Key Energy Services, LLC, I am writing to request the withdrawal of Key Energy's permit application in the matter above, without prejudice.

In August and September 2019, the OCD held an evidentiary hearing to consider the merits of Key Energy's permit application. We have not received a decision to date. Key Energy recently sold its water management business to a third party. As a result, the requested permit for a saltwater disposal well is no longer necessary.
