2 16 on our agenda today, Case 21458, Titus Oil & Gas.

3 MS. SHAHEEN: Sharon Shaheen, Montgomery and
4 Andrews on behalf of Titus Oil & Gas.

5 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: I have an entry from
6 EOG Resources.

7 MS. LUCK: Good morning. Kaitlyn Luck with the
8 Santa Fe office of Holland & Hart on behalf of EOG
9 Resources.

10 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: And COG Operating?

11 MS. RYAN: Beth Ryan here on behalf of COG
12 Operating.

13 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you.

14 Ms. Shaheen, I think you indicated you were going
15 to file a new application in this matter?

16 MS. SHAHEEN: That's correct. Same, same routine
17 here as in the Cane West application. Those well proposals
18 will go out this month, and then we will be filing the
19 applications a month after -- 30 days thereafter.

20 I think March 17 would be a great time to put
21 this on the docket as well if that works for everyone else
22 and for the Division.

23 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Ms. Luck, is EOG
24 going to file other cases?

25 MS. LUCK: No, and actually EOG asked that I

1 notify the Division that EOG doesn't have an interest in
2 these wells anymore, and so EOG doesn't take any position on
3 the cases moving forward.

4 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you. Ms. Ryan,
5 COG's position?

6 MS. RYAN: COG is agreeable to the March 17 date.
7 That would be fine.

8 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: But you're not
9 planning on filing a competing application?

10 MS. RYAN: No.

11 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Okay. All right.
12 Well, let's fill up March 17 then. Is there any other
13 interested persons for Case 21458?

14 (No audible response.)

15 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Hearing none, this
16 will be set for a hearing on March 17, and we will issue a
17 prehearing order.

18 MS. SHAHEEN: Thank you, Mr. Examiner.
