- 2 EXAMINER BRANCARD: With that, we've got a whole
- 3 slew of amendments ahead of us here. I guess we can do
- 4 these all together, but you'll let me know. Cases 46
- 5 through 53, Case Nos. 22385, 22386, 22387, 22388, 22389,
- 6 22390, 22391, 22392, Marathon Oil Permian, LLC.
- 7 MS. BENNETT: Good morning.
- 8 MR. SMITH: Good morning, Mr. Examiner. Bryce
- 9 Smith with Modrall Sperling appearing on behalf of the
- 10 applicant, Marathon Oil Permian, LLC.
- 11 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you.
- 12 So is it Mr. Smith or Ms. Bennett?
- MS. BENNETT: Mr. Hearing Examiner, at this
- 14 point I would like to introduce Mr. Smith. He is an
- 15 associate at Modrall, and I'm happy to have him helping me
- 16 and helping Earl DeBrine. So we are really glad that he
- joined the firm, and he will be presenting the next two
- 18 suites of Marathon cases.
- 19 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you. So let me ask if
- 20 there are any other interested persons for Cases 22385,
- 21 -386, -387, -388, -389, -390, -391, -392.
- 22 UNIDENTIFIED SPEAKER: Those numbers were said
- 23 pretty quick. Did you mention 20470 or Case 20563?
- 24 EXAMINER BRANCARD: No, these are 22385 through
- 25 -392.

- 1 UNIDENTIFIED SPEAKER: Okay.
- 2 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Hearing none, Mr. Smith do
- 3 you want to present these one at a time or try to do them
- 4 all together?
- 5 MR. SMITH: Mr. Examiner, I'd like to
- 6 consolidate these eight cases.
- 7 EXAMINER BRANCARD: All right. Please proceed.
- 8 MR. SMITH: Thank you, Mr. Examiner.
- 9 So these cases, Cases 22385 through 22392
- 10 all pertain to Marathon's second request for an extension
- of time to commence drilling the initial well under the
- 12 orders. We timely filed our exhibitS Tuesday, January
- 13 4th.
- 14 You will find as Tab A the Declaration of
- 15 Jeffrey Broussard, a professional landman for Marathon.
- 16 Jeff Broussard has testified before the Division and his
- 17 credentials have been accepted as a matter of record.
- In his Declaration he explains why Marathon
- 19 is requesting this second extension; namely, Covid and the
- 20 pandemic has continued to impact Marathon's drilling
- 21 schedule; and market conditions, although things are
- 22 improving, there continues to be a lag in getting drilling
- 23 caught up as market conditions have changed.
- 24 Behind his declaration is Marathon's --
- 25 (Note: Audio drop.)

- 1 (Note: Pause.)
- 2 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Mr. Smith, I think you're
- 3 cutting out. Perhaps you should get rid of your video and
- 4 just do audio. Can you hear me?
- 5 Mr. Garcia, are you hearing Mr. Smith?
- 6 EXAMINER GARCIA: No. It shows he's having
- 7 bandwidth issues according to Webex, so he is virtually on
- 8 hold, essentially, until his Internet gets better.
- 9 Turning off the video for him possibly may
- 10 help him.
- 11 EXAMINER BRANCARD: I think he may have gotten
- 12 dropped.
- 13 Ms. Bennett, can you contact Mr. Smith?
- MS. SMITH: My Internet. I guess I'll try
- 15 calling in.
- 16 Can you hear me now?
- 17 EXAMINER BRANCARD: You're back on.
- 18 MS. BENNETT: This is Deana Bennett. I just
- 19 spoke with Mr. Smith and he's calling in. He's having
- 20 some Internet issues, so he's calling in, and he should be
- 21 on in just a few minutes.
- MR. SMITH: Can you hear me now? You said you
- 23 could hear me.
- 24 EXAMINER BRANCARD: We can hear you.
- 25 MR. SMITH: Okay. I'm not sure where I got cut

1 off but I was discussing the exhibits to our application

- 2 which follow Jeff Broussard's Affidavit or Declaration.
- First is his -- the Applications in this
- 4 case for Marathon and, that's followed by our Orders that
- 5 we're seeking to pool.
- 6 And the final exhibit in each packet is the
- 7 Notice Affidavit prepared by our firm. And in the Notice
- 8 Affidavit you will find that Notice was timely given to
- 9 all the required parties in this case. Also included out
- 10 of a matter of habit and abundance of caution is our
- 11 Affidavit of Publication.
- 12 So with that I would ask that exhibits in
- 13 Cases 22385, 22386, 22387, 22388, 22389, 22390, 22391 and
- 14 22392 be admitted into the record and that these cases be
- 15 taken under advisement.
- 16 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you.
- 17 Mr. Garcia, did you have any questions?
- 18 EXAMINER GARCIA: Mr. Smith, is this your first
- 19 time before the Division?
- 20 MR. SMITH: It is, Mr. Garcia.
- 21 EXAMINER GARCIA: Well, I just wanted to make
- 22 you nervous on your first time.
- MR. SMITH: I think so.
- 24 EXAMINER GARCIA: I have no questions.
- 25 EXAMINER BRANCARD: I assume, Mr. Smith, Ms.
