1 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: With that I'm calling

- 2 Item 35, Case 22477, Colgate Operating.
- 3 MS. BENNETT: Good morning, Mr. Examiner. Deana
- 4 Bennett on behalf of Colgate Energy, Colgate Operating LLC.
- 5 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you. Are there
- 6 any other entries of appearance for Case 22477?
- 7 (No audible response.)
- 8 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Hearing none, Ms.
- 9 Bennett, you may proceed.
- 10 MS. BENNETT: Thank you very much, Mr. Hearing
- 11 Examiner. In this case Colgate is requesting a one year
- 12 extension of time to drill the initial well under the order.
- 13 And this is Colgate's first request for an extension of time
- 14 to amend the order, and the order that Colgate is seeking to
- 15 amend is Order Number R-21589.
- 16 And behind the material which we filed on
- 17 Tuesday, you will find the self-affirmed declaration of Mark
- 18 Hajdik, and Mr. Hajdik has previously testified before the
- 19 Division and his credentials have been accepted as a matter
- 20 of record.
- 21 And in his declaration he explains the reasons
- 22 for requesting the additional time to drill the wells, which
- 23 is the continued disruptions of Covid and the impacts it has
- 24 had on Colgate's drilling schedule. Order 21589 pooled
- 25 uncommitted interest owners in a 320 acre Bone Spring

- 1 horizontal spacing unit, and that is the unit that Colgate
- 2 is seeking to have the extension apply to.
- 3 And the original order, under the original order
- 4 Colgate would have been required to drill the initial well
- 5 by February 2, 2022, and Colgate is requesting an additional
- 6 year through February 2, 2023.
- 7 Behind Mr. Hajdik's affidavit we have included
- 8 the order that Colgate is seeking to amend, and then
- 9 Exhibit 3 is the affidavit of, of our office showing that
- 10 the notice application was mailed to the pooled working
- 11 interest owners. What we failed to do at the time, though,
- 12 was publish because we were thinking that all of the letters
- 13 would be mailed out and would be received and so we did not
- 14 publish.
- 15 But in preparing for the hearing, it became clear
- 16 that not all of the letters were received, and some have
- 17 been returned to us. And so yesterday we worked with the
- 18 newspaper to get an affidavit -- to get a publication notice
- 19 for March 3 with the hopes that we could just continue this
- 20 case to March 3 for notice purposes only.
- 21 So with that, I would ask that the exhibits in
- 22 Case Number 22477 be admitted into the record, and I'm
- 23 available for any questions.
- 24 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you. Mr.
- 25 Rose-Coss, any questions?

1 TECHNICAL EXAMINER ROSE-COSS: No questions for

- 2 me.
- 3 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: So Ms. Bennett, when
- 4 is this newspaper publication going to happen?
- 5 MS. BENNETT: Hopefully today. We asked for it
- 6 to happen as quickly as possible, but there was no way to
- 7 get it in time for the February 17 docket. There is not
- 8 enough business days between now and February 17 to have the
- 9 publication fully ripe which is why we included March 3 as
- 10 the date in the publication notice because that's the first
- 11 docket date that -- where there is enough time for the
- 12 publication notice to actually be ripe.
- 13 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Okay. Well, you
- 14 should have enough time. All right. So with that, your
- 15 exhibits will be admitted into the record, and let me ask,
- 16 is there any other interested persons in Case 22477?
- 17 (No audible response.)
- 18 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Hearing none, this
- 19 case will be continued to March 3 for notice purposes.
- Ms. Bennett, since we are continuing the case,
- 21 you don't need to file a continuance.
- 22 MS. BENNETT: Thank you very much, Mr. Examiner.
- 23 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: So we are going to
- 24 take a break here.
