

**NEW MEXICO OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION'S MOTION TO  
CONTINUE HEARING TO DECEMBER 15, 2022**

The New Mexico Oil Conservation Division ("OCD") moves to reschedule the continue the hearing in this matter to December 15, 2022, and states the following in support thereof:

1. On September 9, 2022, OCD docketed the Notice of Violation issued to Permok Oil Inc. ("Permok"), served the docketing notice on Permok by email, and stated that the informal resolution period had expired without resolution of the NOV.
  
3. Shortly before the scheduled hearing on November 9, 2022, OCD's witness, Rob Jackson became unavailable due to illness.
