- 14 The commission had gone into executive
- 15 session in accordance with New Mexico Statute
- 16 10-15-1 and the commission resolution on open

- 18 The only topic for discussion were the
- 19 consolidated cases 14558 and 14577.
- 20 The commission finds in favor of COG for
- 21 vertical expansion of the Burch Keely Unit in Eddy
- 22 County and for vertical expansion of the Grayburg
- 23 Jackson, Seven Rivers, Queen, Grayburg San Andres
- 24 pool, to correspond with the unitized formation of
- 25 the Burch Keely Unit in Eddy County.

The evidence presented to the commission 1 2 supports this approval. And this evidence includes, but is not limited to, the facts that the expansion 3 of the unit is supported by the unit agreement; that in and of itself, approval of the expansion of the 5 unit and the pool will not result in waste or 6 7 interference of correlative rights. This decision will also deny the motion to 8 9 stay.
