CASE 14740 Application of Yates Petroleum Corporation for a non-standard oil spacing and proration unit and compulsory pooling, Eddy County, New Mexico. Applicant seeks an order approving a 160-acre non-standard oil spacing and proration unit (project area) in the Bone Spring formation comprised of the N/2 N/2 of Section 13, Township 18 South, Range 29 East, NMPM. Applicant further seeks the pooling of all uncommitted mineral interests from surface to the base of the Bone Spring formation underlying the N/2 N/2 of Section 13 to form a non-standard 160 acre oil spacing and proration unit (project area), for any formations and/or pools developed on 40 acre spacing within that vertical extent.
