FINDS THAT:

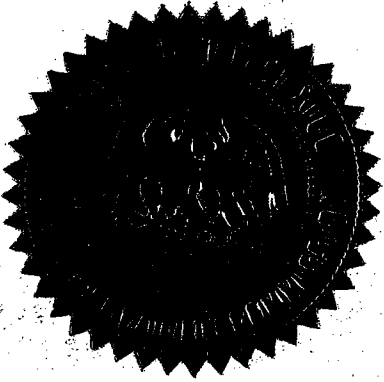
Land Services, Inc., as applicant for hearing De Novo in this case, has requested dismissal thereof and such request should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:


Case 13357 De Novo is hereby dismissed and Division Order No. R-12252 is hereby continued in full force and effect until further notice.
