4 LLC, for approval of a nonstandard oil spacing and oil
5 proration unit and compulsory unit, Eddy County, New
6 Mexico. Call for appearances.

7 MR. KELLAHIN: Mr. Examiner, I'm Tom
8 Kellahin, of the Santa Fe law firm of Kellahin &
9 Kellahin. I'm appearing this morning on behalf of the
10 applicant.

11 This case was heard by Examiner Brooks on
12 November 10th. Following the presentation of the
13 technical case, there was a need to continue the case
14 because additional notification to certain offsetting
15 parties hadn't fully expired. The notice letter to those
16 parties was sent out on November 7th. So in order to

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
