11 To my right is Commissioner Jami Bailey.  
12 Commissioner Bailey is the designee of the Commissioner of  
13 State Lands, Mr. Patrick Lyons.

14 To my left is Mr. Frank Chavez. Mr. Chavez is  
15 the not-quite-former OCD Supervisor in Aztec and the  
16 appointee of New Mexico Energy, Minerals and Natural  
17 Resources Department Secretary, Joanna Prukop.

18 To Mr. Chavez's left is David Brooks. Mr. Brooks  
19 is the Commission counsel.

20 To Commissioner Bailey's right is Florene  
21 Davidson. Ms. Davidson is the Commission Secretary.

22 And Mr. Steve Brenner is the court reporter  
23 today, as in every other day that I've been around.

24 Let the record reflect that all Commissioners or  
25 their deisngees are present.

CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: And the first matter of business is the adoption of the minutes of the meeting held January 13th, 2005.

Have the Commissioners had the opportunity to review the minutes?

COMMISSIONER BAILEY: Yes, I have, and I move that we adopt them.

CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: Commissioner Chavez?

COMMISSIONER CHAVEZ: I second the motion.

CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: The motion having been made and seconded, all those in favor signify by saying aye.

COMMISSIONER BAILEY: Aye.

COMMISSIONER CHAVEZ: Aye.

2     special rules and regulations for the Dos Hermanos-Morrow  
3     Gas Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico.

4             On application of the Applicant, they have asked  
5     that this case be continued to the March 8th, 2005,  
6     Commission meeting. That Application was granted, and this  
7     case will be continued to the March Commission meeting.

10            CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: The next item on the agenda,  
11     we should probably address the report of the committee that  
12     was organized and empowered by the Commission to look into  
13     rules and procedures for the Commission and the Oil  
14     Conservation Division.

15            At this time I'll ask Counsel Brooks to address  
16     that for us.

17            MR. BROOKS: Yes, Mr. Chairman, honorable  
18     Commissioners. The committee has been unable to assemble  
19     in preparation for this hearing; various members' schedules  
20     have not jibed so that we could get a meeting together. So  
21     we are not in a position to make a final report at this  
22     time and request that that matter be deferred until the  
23     March 8th hearing.

24            CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: The Chair sees no reason why  
25     it shouldn't be deferred to the March meeting. Is there

1 any objection from the Commissioners?

2 COMMISSIONER BAILEY: No.

3 COMMISSIONER CHAVEZ: No objection.

4 CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: Okay. We will take Counsel  
5 Brooks' suggestion and postpone that report to the March  
6 meeting.
