EXECUTED, this 10<sup>th</sup> day of May 2004 but made effective as of the 1st day of May 2004.

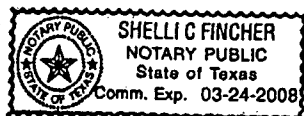
