1. **CASE 14776:** *Application of Yates Petroleum Corporation for Approval of a Non-Standard Spacing and Proration Unit, Lea County, New Mexico.* Yates Petroleum Corporation has applied for approval of a non-standard 80-acre oil spacing and proration unit in the Salt Lake-Delaware Pool, comprising the SE/4 NE/4 and NE/4 SE/4 of Section 14, Township 20 South, Range 32 East, NMPM in Lea County. This location is approximately 30 miles west of Hobbs, New Mexico.
2. **CASE 14777:** *Application of Yates Petroleum Corporation for Approval of a Non-Standard Spacing and Proration Unit, Lea County, New Mexico.* Yates Petroleum Corporation has applied for approval of a non-standard 80-acre oil spacing and proration unit in the Salt Lake-Delaware Pool, comprising the SE/4 NW/4 and NE/4 SW/4 of Section 14, Township 20 South, Range 32 East, NMPM in Lea County. This location is approximately 30 miles west of Hobbs, New Mexico.

**Application of Mack Energy Corporation for compulsory pooling, Lea County, New Mexico.** Mack Energy Corporation seeks an order pooling all mineral interests from the surface to the base of the Abo formation underlying the SE/4 NW/4 of Section 32, Township 17 South, Range 33 East, N.M.P.M. The unit is dedicated to the Cockburn A State Well No. 5, an existing well to be re-completed in the Abo formation. Also to be considered will be the cost of re-completing the well and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the well, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in re-completing the well. The unit is located approximately 5 miles south-southwest of Maljamar, New Mexico.
