    Applicant seeks an order proposing to convert to water disposal its Hinkle B Federal No. 19 well, located 990 FNL and 330 FWL, Unit D, Section 34, Township 18 South, Range 31 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico. The disposal zones shall be in the Queen/Grayburg formation at a depth of 3410 feet to 3902 feet below the surface of the earth perforated. The Hinkle B Federal No. 19 is located approximately 16 miles southeast of Loco Hills, New Mexico.
